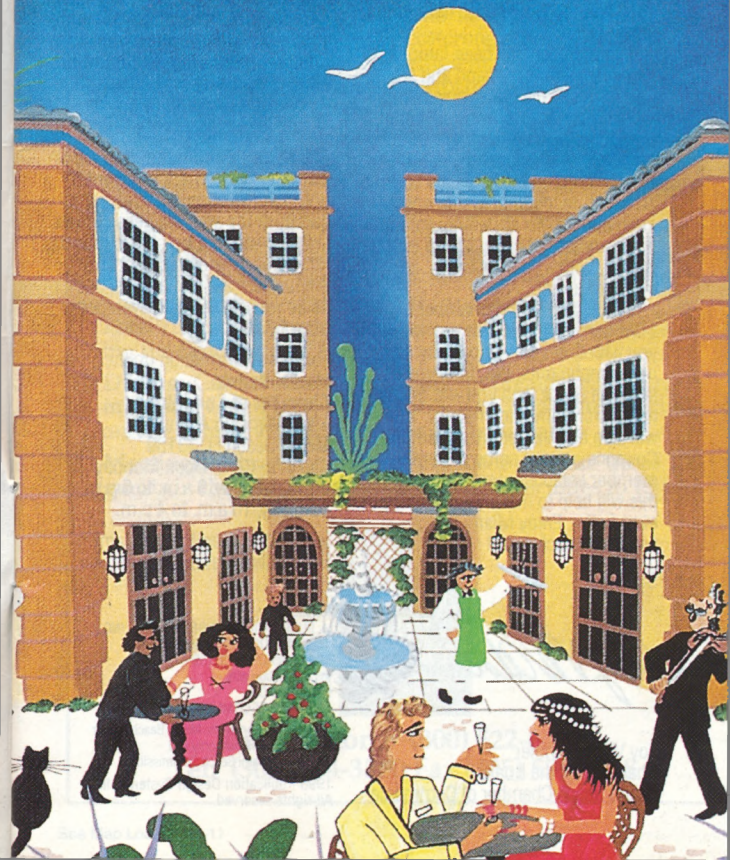

RITZ PLAZA HOTEL

1701 Collins Avenue, Miami Beach, FL 33139

Located on the ocean in the heart of Miami Beach's internationally known Art Deco District, the Ritz Plaza is one of the area's most striking hotels. Built in the early 1940s in the Deco style known as Art Moderne, its simplified, clean lines incorporate the characteristic concrete, smooth-faced stone and metal detail that suggest efficient machine production - a somber reflection of the austerity of the Great Depression infused with optimism for the future. Restored at a cost of \$5.5 million, the hotel has been sensitively returned to its original beauty and ambience, retaining its original cast-iron bathtubs - in fully modernized bathrooms - and original ceramic tile.

Amenities: 128 guest rooms, 4 suites, Olympic-size pool and ocean beach; near Miami Beach Convention Center, Theatre for the Performing Arts and Miami Seaport. The hotel's tour desk arranges visits to nearby attractions including the Seaquarium, Everglades, and local cruises.

Dining: Casual yet elegant dining for breakfast and dinner in the Ritz Cafe; Harry's Bar for lunch and light fare; cocktails and light lunches offered at the poolside bar.

Meetings: Three meeting rooms accommodate up to 130 guests in theatre-style seating. Banquet facilities to 150.

TRANSPORTATION

All aboard Dade County transit... MetroBus, MetroRail and Metro-Mover help a quarter million people get where they're going every day.

METROBUS

MetroBus 638-6700/voice, 638-7266/TDD. More than 19 of the 63 Dade County Routes serve Downtown Miami and the beaches every day, as well as the Miami Seaquarium, the Orange Bowl Stadium, the Cultural Center, and Metrozoo. Fares are \$1.25 each way, exact change only. Seniors, people with disabilities, and students (grades

1 through 12) with proper identification: 60 cents all day.

MetroBus Fares

Transfers: 25 cents

Bus-to Rail transfers: 50 cents

MetroBus connects with Dade County MetroRail stations. Call 638-6700 for MetroBus and MetroRail route information.

MetroBuses operate Monday-Friday, 4:30 a.m. -2:13 a.m. Call 638-6700 for specific routes and weekend schedule.

METRO-RAIL

The 21-mile MetroRail elevated rail system can take you from South Miami downtown quickly and easily. You can get on at one of 20 stations and whisk your way over scenic Miami above the roads and highways.

METROMOVER

Metromover 638-6700. Individual motorized cars run atop a 1.9 mile elevated track looping around Downtown Miami and connecting to MetroRail at the Government Center station. Stops include Bayside Marketplace, Miami Arena, the Cultural Center, some downtown hotels, and the Miami Convention Center. The fare is \$.25; \$.10 for seniors, people with disabilities, and students with rail permit. Metromover operates every 90 seconds, daily 6 a.m. - midnight.

TRI-RAIL

Tri-Rail 1-800-273-7545/TDD, FL

1-800-TRI-RAIL. This commuter rail system with 15 stations throughout Dade and Broward Counties services the area between Miami and West Palm Beach. Tri-Rail connects directly to Metro-Rail for convenient access to or from Downtown and South Miami at no additional cost. The fare is \$2.50 each way, \$5.00 daily, \$18.00 weekly, or \$22.50 for the "Fast Track 12 Pak" coupon book valid for 12 trips. A 50% fare discount applies to seniors, students, and people with disabilities. Children under 5 ride free. Trains operate daily except Thanksgiving and Christmas. Tri-Rail also serves many special events.

METRO-DADE COUNTY TRANSIT SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

MetroDade County Transit Special Transportation Service 266-5406. Open Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. People who qualify must submit an application which takes approximately three weeks to process. The Special Transportation Service (STS) provides a curb-to-curb service. 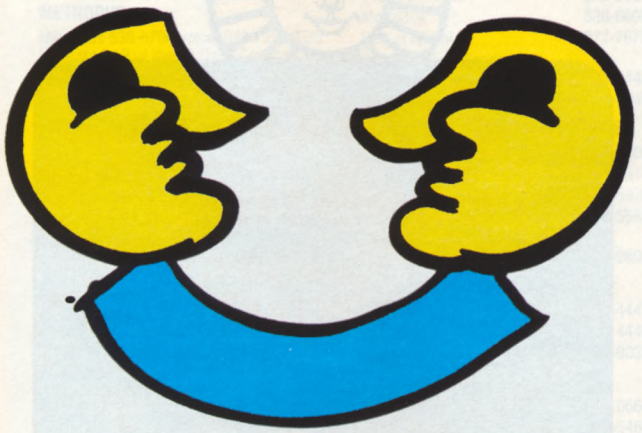

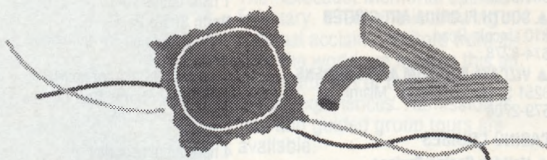

HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL

The Holocaust Memorial, 1933-45 Meridian Avenue, provides a dramatic tribute to the six-million Jewish victims of Nazi terrorism during World War II, in a powerful display of pain and suffering. At the center of the Memorial is a startling monument— a bronze arm and hand stretched toward the sky, and struggling to climb it, life-sized sculptures depicting the horrified victims of the Holocaust. Around the monument, the walls of a tunnel-like passage chronicle the images of the now-infamous death camps.

A photographic history of some of the darkest years in human history is etched into black granite. The "Memorial Wall" is inscribed with the names of loved ones who perished in the Holocaust.

Designed by acclaimed sculptor Kenneth Treister, the Holocaust Memorial is constructed of Jerusalem stone and marble. The sculpture itself is part of a lily-filled reflection pond in the middle of the plaza. Visitors may stroll at their own paces through the various exhibits.

The Holocaust Memorial opened in February, 1990, and is drawing national acclaim. Visitors from all over the world are making this an important part of their Miami Beach experiences. Admission is free and guided group tours are available.

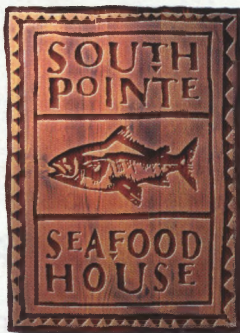

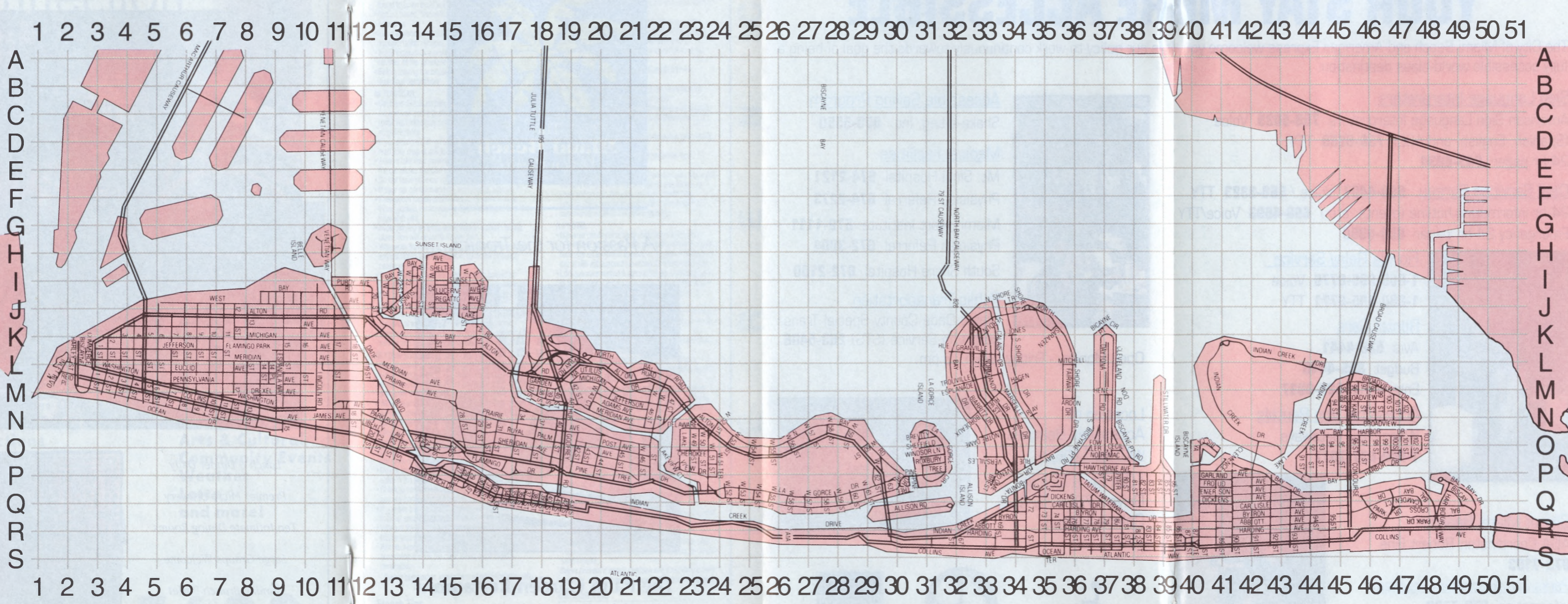

TRAVELER SAFETY TIPS

English Tips

To help you enjoy a safe and secure vacation, we have compiled the following common sense safety tips.

AT THE AIRPORT

- Never store valuables – cash, jewelry – in your luggage and never leave baggage unattended.
- Band your luggage as a safeguard. Placing a strap or tie around the luggage or a seal on the zipper has been found to be an excellent deterrent against pilferage.
- Secure buses, limousines and taxis at authorized pick-up points.
- Avoid anyone who solicits you with allegedly low-cost transportation services.
- If you experience a problem, note the identification number of the vehicle for investigative purposes.
- Before leaving the airport, get specific directions to your final destination.

IN YOUR CAR

- Get clear directions before you set out in your rental car and use a map to plan your route. Ask the car rental representative or hotel concierge for step-by-step directions.
- If you become lost, go to the nearest public place to read your map or ask for directions.
- Always take your parking ticket with you. Leaving it in the car allows the thief to exit the parking lot.
- Do not leave your car running unattended.
- If your car contains an anti-theft device, activate it.
- Keep doors locked and windows up while driving. When parked, remember to do the same and take the keys with you.
- Avoid leaving an extra set of keys in a secret hiding place. You will never fool a car thief.
- Whenever traveling or leaving a parked vehicle, lock any packages and valuables in the trunk of the car before setting out.
- While driving, if you are bumped from behind or flashed by headlights, or see someone who indicates they need help, do not stop. Drive to the nearest, well-lit public area and dial the police at 911.
- If someone suspicious approaches your vehicle while stopped at a traffic light or sign, blow the horn.
- Park in well-lit areas and check the interior of the vehicle and surrounding areas before entering the car.

IN YOUR HOTEL

- Do not answer the door in a hotel or motel room without verifying who it is. If a person claims to be an employee, call the front desk and ask if someone from their staff is supposed to have access to your room.
- When returning to your hotel or motel late in the evening, use the main entrance of the hotel. Be observant and look around before entering parking lots.
- Close the door securely whenever you are in your room and use all of the locking devices provided.
- Do not draw attention to yourself by displaying large amounts of cash or expensive jewelry.
- Do not invite strangers to your room. Place all valuables in the hotel or motel safe deposit box.
- Check to see that any sliding glass doors or windows and any connecting room doors are locked.
- If you see any suspicious activity, report it immediately to hotel security or the front desk.
- When at the pool or beach never leave purses or wallets or keys unattended or out of sight.
- Ask your concierge for specific directions when you are driving and for the most direct route to your destination.

Please remember, regardless of where you travel, crime never takes a vacation.

On May 14, "Summer Stock,"
comprising three small exhibitions, opens

works on paper, objects, and posters that
capture the Roaring Twenties in Miami
and Miami Beach. "Culinary Culture"
demonstrates how innovations in kitchen
appliances and tablewares were advertised
and incorporated into the early twentieth-
century home – and even used to promote
