Dear Mr. Axelson:

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of June 2nd and send you herewith copy of the bill recently passed by both Houses of Congress creating the Everglades National Park which is now a law.

I am proposing a meeting of the landowners within the Park area to be held at my office, 606 Ingraham Building, Miami, Florida, at 2:30 P. M. on June 27th and I hope that you may be able to attend, if not, after the meeting I will send you detailed information as to that meeting and later on we can hold another meeting somewhere in the North in order that property owners residing in the North may be able to express their views as to the Park proposition.

Mr. George Cook of Miami will represent the Chevalier Corporation and I am, today, writing Mr. Klipstein who, of course, is representative of the Palgrove Company.

The reason for holding the meeting in Miami is that there are so many representatives of owners in Miami that we will probably have a better representation than if it was held in the North and, as stated, if you are unable to attend we may be able to arrange a later meeting so that you and Mr. Klipstein and others may be present and express your views as to the Park matter.
