INTRODUCTION

Greater Miami is currently involved in a \$200 million expressway program. This program is affecting the City of Miami in numerous ways. To many, certain aspects of this important project are somewhat nebulous.

This report attempts to shed some light on the subject. Included is a discussion of such topics as: the events leading up to the current expressway plan; a description of the proposed system; special problems being encountered; and, current progress and schedules.
