Dear Mr. Danner:

Presented herewith is the report of the survey of street parking and transportation in the central business district of Miami, which has been conducted by this Division.

This is in reality a combination of a study of street parking conditions and practices with the second part of the Mass Transportation Survey, Part I of which was presented in July of this year. Parking and transportation problems are so closely related in the downtown area that it was felt that they should be treated together in this report.

Since this report deals with many inter-related matters constituting a comprehensive plan for improving the use of the downtown streets, it is hoped that the complete plan will receive consideration and approval as a unified program toward the accomplishment of which the City can proceed at once.
