INTRODUCTION

From 1955 through 1963, the City of Miami prepared and printed a Capital Improvement Report. This was a compilation of the City's overall Capital Improvement needs with particular emphasis placed on the forthcoming six year period.

This report was most helpful in planning and coordinating the activities of the Department of Public Works particularly as related to the needs and activities of other departments.

In order to fill the void which existed since the report was last printed in 1963, the Department of Public Works, in 1970, prepared a compilation of "Capital Improvement Information - City of Miami, Florida." This was compiled principally from data available within the Department. Contact with other departments on this matter was limited.

It was the general intent to periodically update this compilation to keep pace with any changes that might take place. This is the first such updating which is now planned to be undertaken on a bi-annual basis.
