Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check in the sum of 5 per cent of the amount of the bid, made payable to the City of Miami and certified by a reputable banking institution as assurance that within ten days after notice of award of contract contemplated in the proposal, the successful bidder will enter such contract and file a bond for the proper performance of the same.

All certified checks will be retained by the City Clerk as property of the bidder until bids are opened and award of contract made or all bids rejected. After an award has been made the checks of all bidders, other than the one to whom said contract is awarded, shall be returned.

The bond required shall be in the sum of the nearest even one hundred dollars to 25 per cent of the amount bid, and shall be made by some surety company acceptable to the City of Miami, Florida.

In default of the entering into such contract and the execution of such bond, the certified check required to accompany such bid shall be forfeited to the City of Miami, Florida, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages for the delay or additional cost which may be incurred by the city by reason of such default.

No bid will be permitted to be withdrawn for any reason whatever after having been filed with the Clerk.

AN ORDINANCE SI-42 PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT IN ANNUAL INSTALMENTS OF ASSESSMENTS OF \$25.00 AND OVER MADE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COST OF IMPROVEMENT OF laying, constructing and installing on Avenue I beginning at 2x First St and extending southwardly to near Fifth St. an eight inch vitrified pipe sever, approximate distance 1825 ft IN THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, UNDER IMPROVEMENT RESOLUTION No. 450-B , AND FIXING A TIME WHEN SAID ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT. WHEREAS, the improvement of laying, constructing and installing on Avenue I kex beginning at First St and extending southwardly to near Fifth St. an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer, approximate distance 1225 feet as provided for in Improvement Resolution No. 450-B adopted by this body on October 5,1914 , 191 has been duly completed; and, WHEREAS, said improvement has been accepted by said City and the cost thereof assessable against abutting property has been duly assessed against the property liable to be assessed therefor; now, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miami, Florida, Section 1. That each assessment of \$25.00 and over heretofore made against any one lot or parcel of ground for Avenue I or on account of the improvement of... Street, from Street to near Fifth St First Street Street, in said City of Miami, under Improvement Resolution No.... adopted by this body on Oot 5, 1914 , 19 , may, at the option of the owner or owners of the property so assessed, and upon such owner or owners executing and filing the agreement provided for in Section 30 of the Charter of said City, be payable in two equal annual instalments. The first instalment shall become due and payable July 1,1916 , 19 .. Each succeeding instalment shall become due and payable on the ket day of July of each succeeding year, and bear interest from date at the rate of eight per centum per annum from date until paid. Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after approval by the Mayor, and after its publication one time in the Miami Daily Metropolis, a newspaper published in the City of Miami, Florida, or posting as required by law.
