BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be, and is hereby directed, to advertise for bids for the improvements above described, by the insertion of a notice one time in a daily newspaper published in the City of

Miami, Florida, of bids to be received on Celock ober 15th, until five o'clock P. M. Such advertisement shall state that the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids; that the contract for the imprevement shall provide for the guaranty for the period of five years of the proper completion of the contract and that payment of the cost will be made from time to time to the amount of eighty per centum of estimates of the City Engineer of the amount of work done, in cash or in certificates of indebtedness of the City of Miami, payable from assessments to be hereafter levied, which certificates of indebtedness the city covenants to pay in each or to fund at per within sixty days after the improvement shall have been completed and accepted, by special improvement bonds, authorized by Section 32 of the City Charter, constituting alien upon the property abutting said improvements. Such advertisement may provide the condition of deposit and bidding, which shall be as follows:

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check in the sum of 5 per cent of the amount of the bid, made payable to the City of Miami and certified by a reputable banking institution as assurance that within ten days after notice of award of contract contemplated in the proposal, the successful bidder will enter such contract and file a bond for the proper performance of the same.

All certified checks will be retained by the City Clerk as property of the bidder until bids are opened and award of contract made or all bids rejected. After an award has been made the checks of all bidders, other than the one to whom said contract is awarded, shall be returned.

The bond required shall be in the sum of the nearest even one hundred dollars to 25 per cent of the amount bid, and shall be made by some surety company acceptable to the City of Miami, Florida.



IN THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, UNDER IMPROVEMENT RESOLUTION No. 449-B A TIME WHEN SAID ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT. WHEREAS, the improvement of Laying, constructing and installing on Avenue J beginning at 4th St. and extending northwardly to 2nd St. an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer, approximate distance 700 ft. as provided for in Improvement Resolution No. 449-B adopted by this body on Oct. 5, 1914 has been duly completed; and, WHEREAS, said improvement has been accepted by said City and the cost thereof assessable against abutting property has been duly assessed against the property liable to be assessed therefor; now, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miami, Florida, Section 1.
