

#### IMPROVEMENT RESOLUTION No. 438-B

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Miami, Florida, that it is desired and deemed necessary to construct, lay and install

laying, constructing and installing on Second Street, beginning at Avenue J and extending eastwardly to Avenue F an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer, approximate distance 2300 fest.

as shown in the plans for said improvement and in accordance with the plans, details, profiles, drawings and specifications of the City Engineer, approved and adopted at a meeting of this body, held on Cook 5 11,914, by Resolution No. 138-00, the same being hereby, by reference to said resolution, incorporated herein and made a part hereof, and said improvement is now ordered.

TWO-THIRDS of the total cost of laying an eight inch sewer for the above improvement is to be paid by special assessment to be levied upon the property specially benefited thereby, and the remaining one-third of the total cost of laying an eight inch sewer for the above improvement, and the entire cost of such improvement at the intersection of streets or alleys, is to be paid by the City of Miami.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be, and is hereby directed, to advertise for bids for the improvements above described, by the insertion of a notice one time in a daily newspaper published in the City of

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check in the sum of 5 per cent of the amount of the bid, made payable to the City of Miami and certified by a reputable banking institution as assurance that within tended days after notice of award of contract contemplated in the proposal, the successful bidder will enter such contract and file a bond for the proper performance of the same.

All certified checks will be retained by the City Clerk as property of the bidder until bids are opened and award of contract made or all bids rejected. After an award has been made the checks of all bidders, other than the one to whom said contract is awarded, shall be returned.

The bond required shall be in the sum of the nearest even one hundred dollars to 25 per cent of the amount bid, and shall be made by some surety company acceptable to the City of Miami, Florida.

In default of the entering into such contract and the execution of such bond, the certified check required to accompany such bid shall be forfeited to the City of Miami, Florida, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages for the delay or additional cost which may be incurred by the city by reason of such default.

No bid will be permitted to be withdrawn for any reason whatever after having been filed with the Clerk.

AN ORDINANCE SI-38 PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT IN ANNUAL INSTALMENTS OF ASSESSMENTS OF \$25.00 AND OVER MADE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COST OF IMPROVEMENT OF laying, constructing and installing on 2nd St. beginning at Avenue J and extending eastwardly to Avenue F, an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer, approximate distance 2200 feet. IN THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA, UNDER IMPROVEMENT RESOLUTION No. 438-B , AND FIXING A TIME WHEN SAID ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT. WHEREAS, the improvement of laying, constructing and installing on 2nd St. beginning at Avenue J and extending eastwardly to Avenue F an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer, approximate distance 2200feet. as provided for in Improvement Resolution No. 438-B adopted by this body on Oct 5,1914 , 191 has been duly completed; and, WHEREAS, said improvement has been accepted by said City and the cost thereof assessable against abutting property has been duly assessed against the property liable to be assessed therefor; now, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miami, Florida, Section 1. That each assessment of \$25.00 and over heretofore made against any one lot or parcel of ground for 2nd Street Street, from or on account of the improvement of... 




