"Each year the Florida Folk Festival presents the varied traditions and customs of Floridians reflected in music, average Floridian," said Firestone.


Programs begin at 10 a.m., on Friday (May 27), Saturday and Sunday and will continue into the evening each day. Admission is \$5 per day for adults and \$1 for children (age 6-15); a weekend ticket is also offered at \$12 per adult.

There is no provision for public camping within the park, but there are a number of state parks and commercial campgrounds within easy driving distance of the Center. Many national chain motels are located in nearby Lake City, Live Oak, and Jasper.

The Stephen Foster State Folk Culture Center is located on US 41, in White Springs, 12 miles north of Lake City and 3 miles east of I-75, via SR 136.
