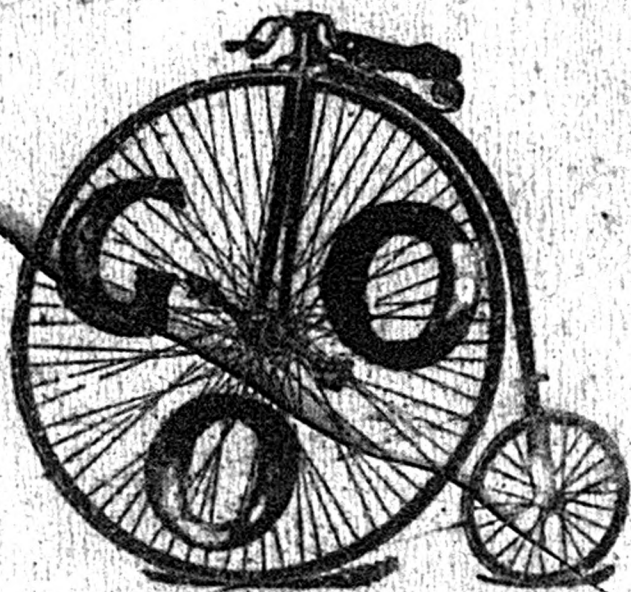

Zig Zag Club formed in Hay & Willet's Bicycle Store on August 8, 1890, moving to the corner of Washington and Alabama Streets over what is now the Indiana Dry Goods Company store; later to the second floor of what was later known as the Lorraine Hotel, Washington Street and Capitol Avenue, opposite the State House; then to North Pennsylvania Street below North Street on the east side of Pennsylvania, which site was later covered by the North Building of the Shortridge High School; and later to a house on the west side of North Delaware Street between Ohio and Wabash Streets in the rear of the house adjoining the dressing rooms and stage of the old Empire Theatre. The Club occupied this site when it disbanded about 1895 or 1896.
