For instance, I probably buy more books as presents than any other man in the United States. I received just last week over 300 books. Three years ago I bought 3,000 copies of just one book. I have bought Tom Masson's Annual until the copy is exhausted. Yet, with all the books I buy, I have never yet had a letter from any publisher advising me of a certain book that is good or that is new. Nost publishers I buy books from are either independently rich or apparently have no sales policy whatever. If you want to write something about these publishers, you can give them a little hell for We have done this much; we have organized a company for all of our purchases, so that we do buy books at a discount from the uplishers. the publishers only knew their job, they could get a list of the buyers of their best "sellers" and continue to sell new issues. Most of the publishers I have come in contact with would starve to death selling automobiles or cicycles. love to see you soon. Yours,
