Dear Bill:

I have yours of the 1<sup>st</sup>. Of course, the only way I would accept the \$5. back from the publishers would be with interest.

I often wonder how some publishers and some newspaper men ever have a chance to get by. For instance, I probably buy more books as presents than any other man in the United States. I received just last week over 300 books. Three years ago I bought 3,000 copies of just one book. I have bought Tom Masson's Annual until the copy is exhausted. Yet, with all the books I buy, I have never yet had a letter from any publisher advising me of a certain book that is good or that is new. Most publishers I buy books from are either independently rich or apparently have no sales policy whatever.

If you want to write something about these publishers, you can give them a little hell for me. We have done this much; we have organized a company for all of our purchases, so that we do buy books at a discount from the publishers. If the publishers only knew their job, they could get a list of the buyers of their best "sellers" and continue to sell new issues. Most of the publishers I have come in contact with would starve to death selling automobiles or bicycles.
