# THE INNOVATING FINANCIAL MECHANISMS FOR WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE

The first Central and West Africa Conference on the Innovating Financial Mechanisms for water, sanitation and hygiene organized by the UNICEF in collaboration with the Senegalese Government and the African Ministers' Council in charge of water, was held from December 15th to 17th, 2015 in Dakar, in Senegal. The objective was to find new mechanisms making it possible to collect some 20 to 30 billion dollars needed by the WASH sector every year in order to achieve the universal access to water and sanitation in Central and West Africa.

On this occasion, 24 sub-regional governments could meet representatives of the main investment banks, international organizations and world of business as well as experts. AfWA's Executive Director, who attended this conference, tied contacts with trade banks eager to invest in the sector in Africa, in order to present the programs of the organization, in particular, with regard to the issue relating to Non-Revenue Water.

#### SENEGAL YOUNG PROFESSIONALS PRESENT THEIR PROJECTS

The Association of Senegal Young Water and Sanitation Professionals organized a restitution workshop relating to the projects implemented within the framework of the USAID/FABRI small grants project. The workshop was held on Saturday, December 19, 2015, in Dakar. The first project, achieved by a young professional of the SDE, was entitled: "Faecal sludge management in the suburban area of Dakar: Possible hazard on drinking water supply sources and public health". The second project related to the "Contribution to the reduction of water losses in the private fields in Dakar".

The coordinator of the African Young Water and Sanitation Professionals' project within AfWA, Valentin Yao, was in Dakar to a follow-up-evaluation mission, visited field to note the good progress of the various projects. He noted with satisfaction, the commitment of Senegal young professionals and welcomed the support from the head companies, namely SDE and ONAS.
