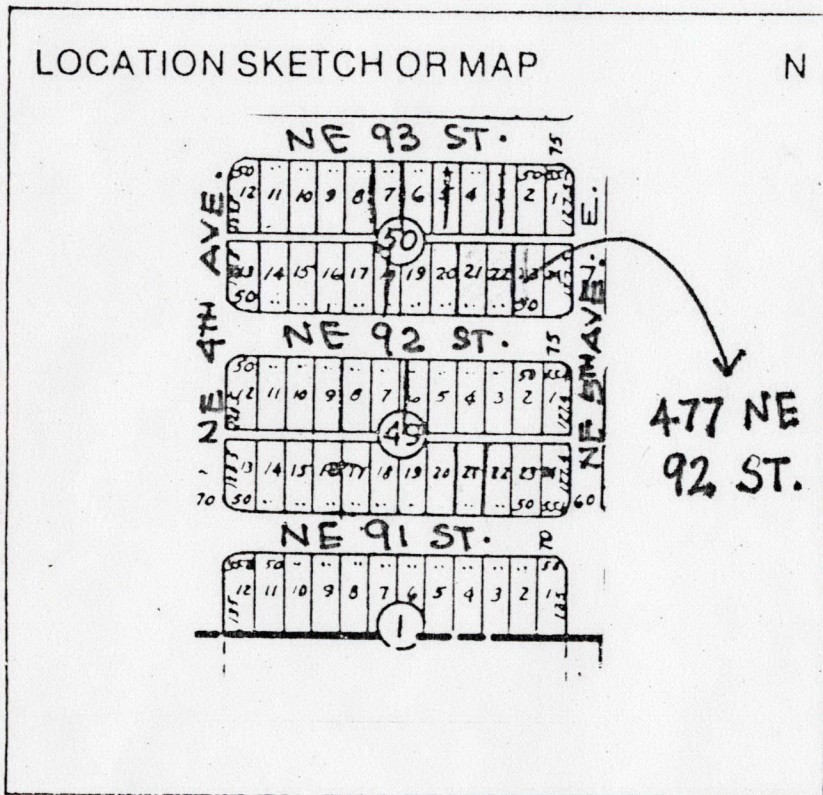

Significance:
 Structure is a fine example of the Mediterranean Revival homes built as part of the original Miami Shores development. Home was built as a spec residence by Town & Farm Realty, one of the active builders in the subdivision. The architect, Marion Manley, was the first registered woman architect in Dade County and designed several other important Miami Shores homes. Structure is in scale and character with the neighborhood. Noteworthy features include the entry portico with three open bays separated by fluted columns of Doric influence.

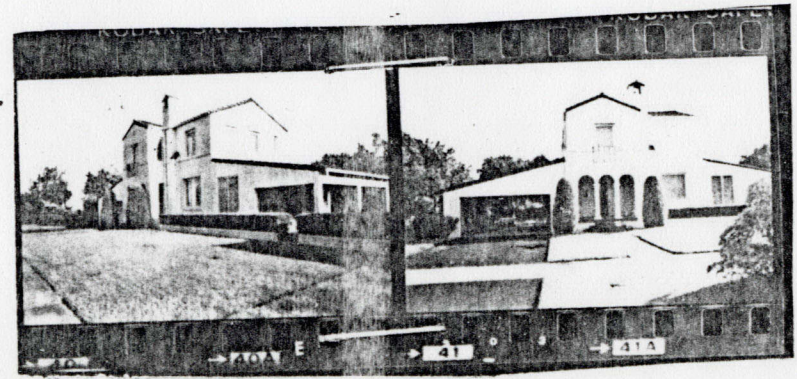

Physical description:

Structure is a Mediterranean Revival style two-story residence. The entry portico on S has three arched bays separated by fluted columns, Doric order; pattern repeated by semi-circular steps. Second story above entry has window (originally French doors) with wrought iron balconette. A porte cochere W and roofed terrace E create the illusion of a central block with symmetrical wings. A detached garage is located at the rear (N). A beltcourse is applied above 1st story.
