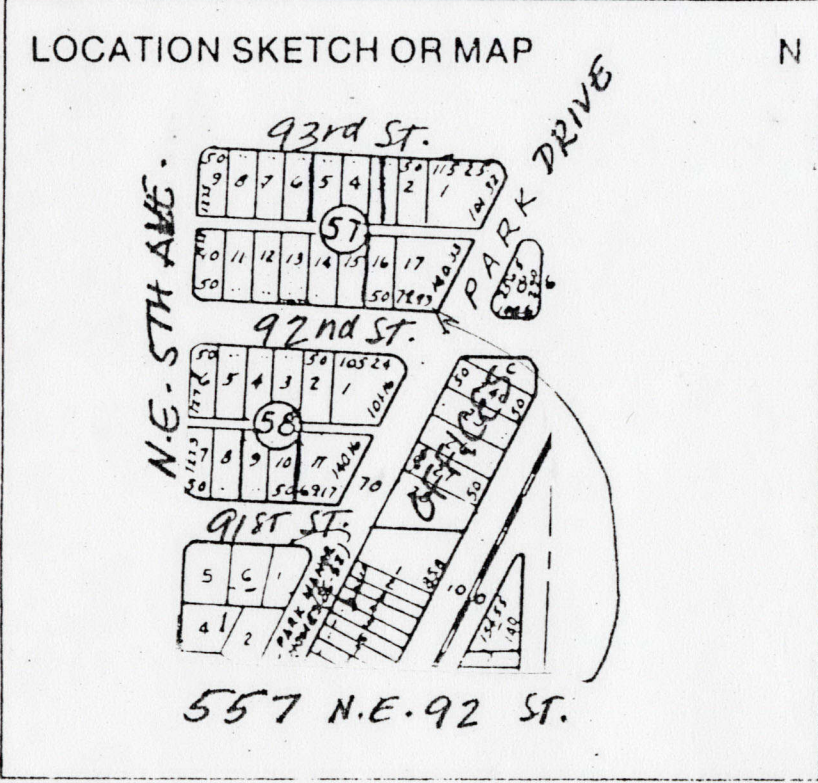

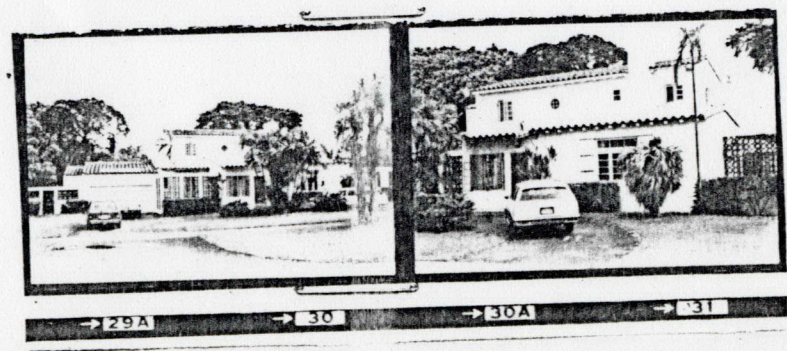

CONTINUATION SHEET

Physical Description:

Structure is masonry vernacular with significant Mediterranean Revival influence. A front screened porch (S) now is enclosed with a variety of materials including aluminum casement windows. 2nd story front (S) facade has polygonal window in center. Ends of gables have horizontal weatherboard siding. The roof eaves have exposed brackets. Decorative hollow clay tile walls extend from E and W front corners, exaggerating the already significant lateral massing. Attached garage. Area to the immediate west is single-story professional offices, not threatening or impacting the residential neighborhood.

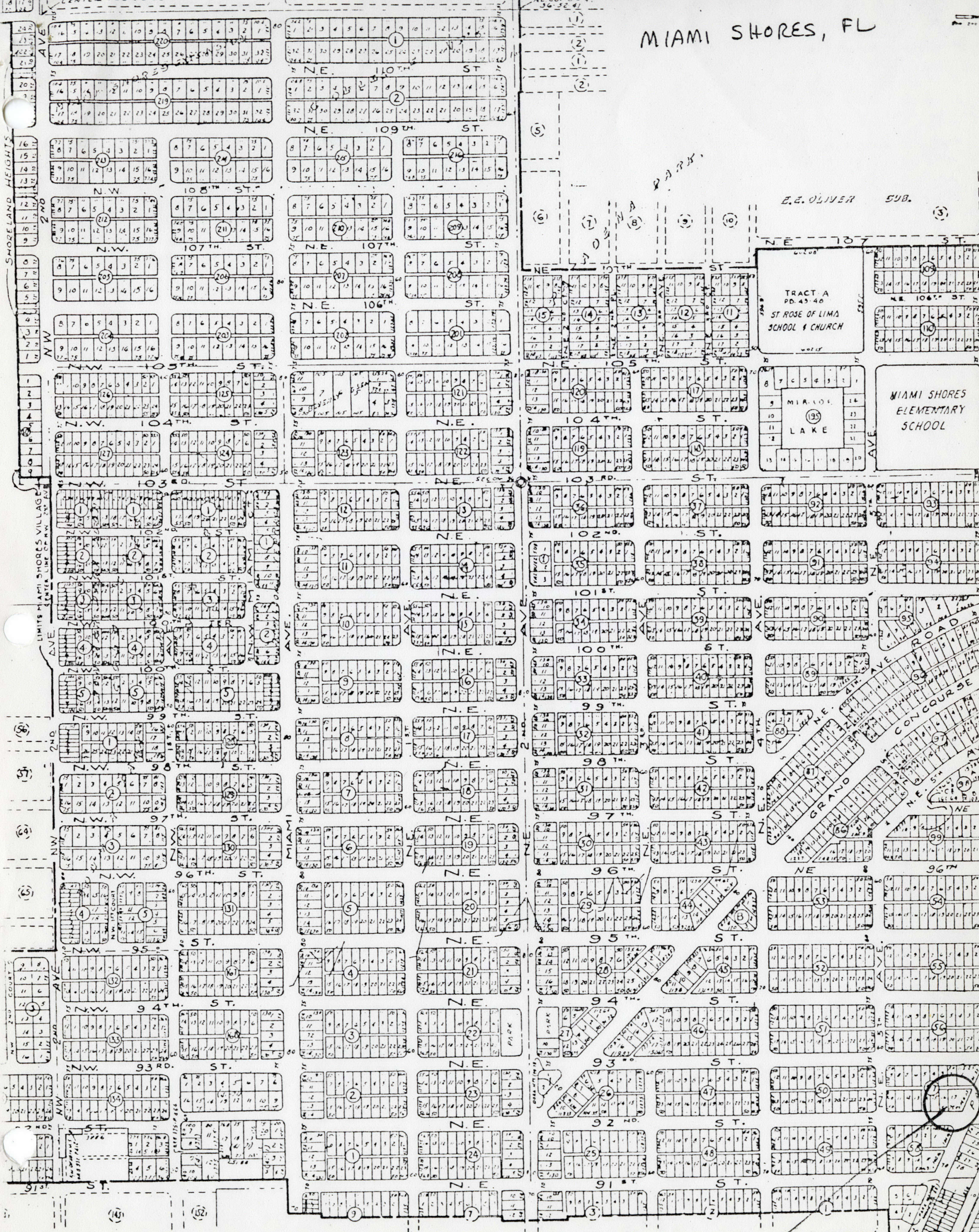
