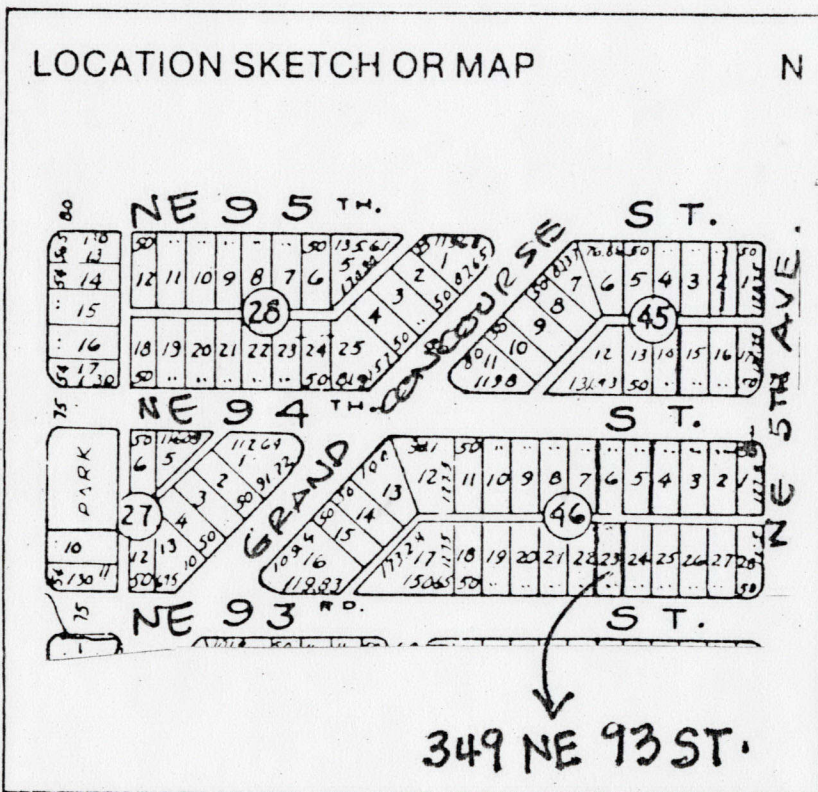

Significance:
 Structure is an excellent example of the Mediterranean Revival design as applied to a medium-size home. Noteworthy features include arched transom windows on first floor, a molded masonry entrance surround and French doors leading to a masonry balcony with wrought iron railing on the 2nd story facade over the main entrance. Structure is in scale and character with the neighborhood and is one of the homes built as part of the original Miami Shores development. The home is a designated Miami Shores landmark.

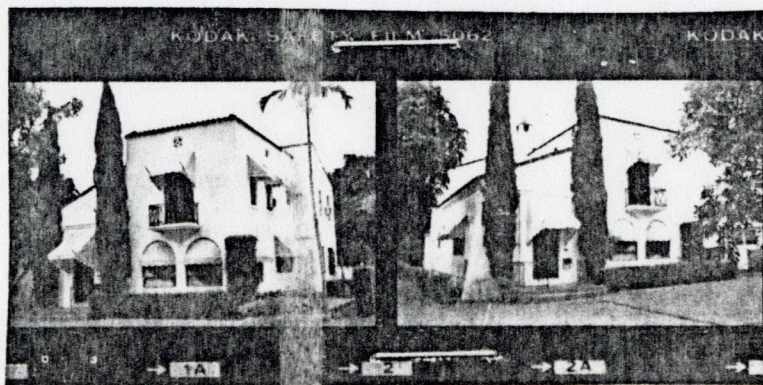

Physical Description:

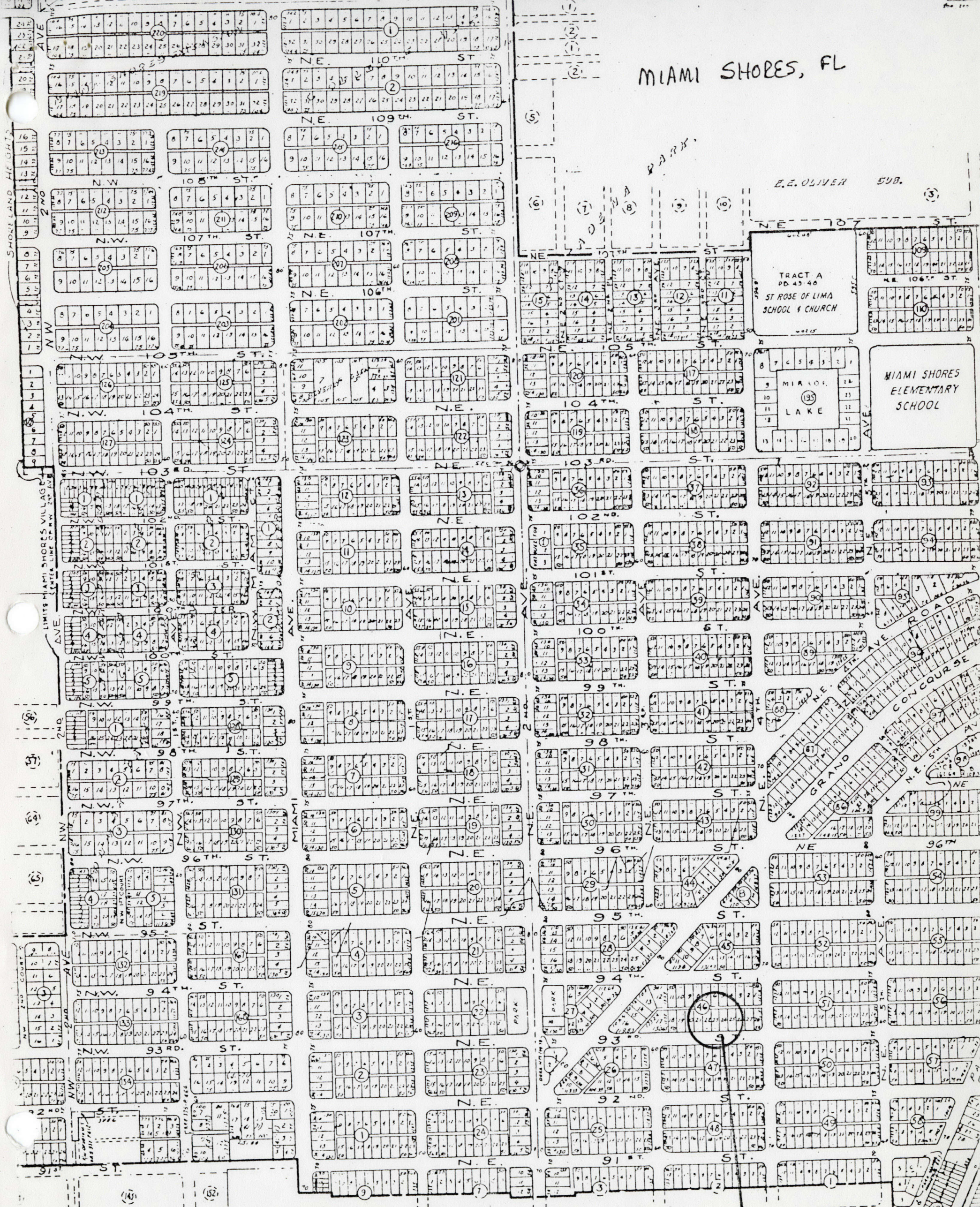
Home is a two-story Mediterranean Revival structure. A single-story entry area on the SW corner has a shed roof with molded masonry surrounding door. First story windows have arched glass transoms and canvas awnings. There is a pair of French doors leading to a molded masonry balcony on 2nd story facade (S); wrought iron railing. Masonry buttresses extend from both sides of the front (S) facade.
