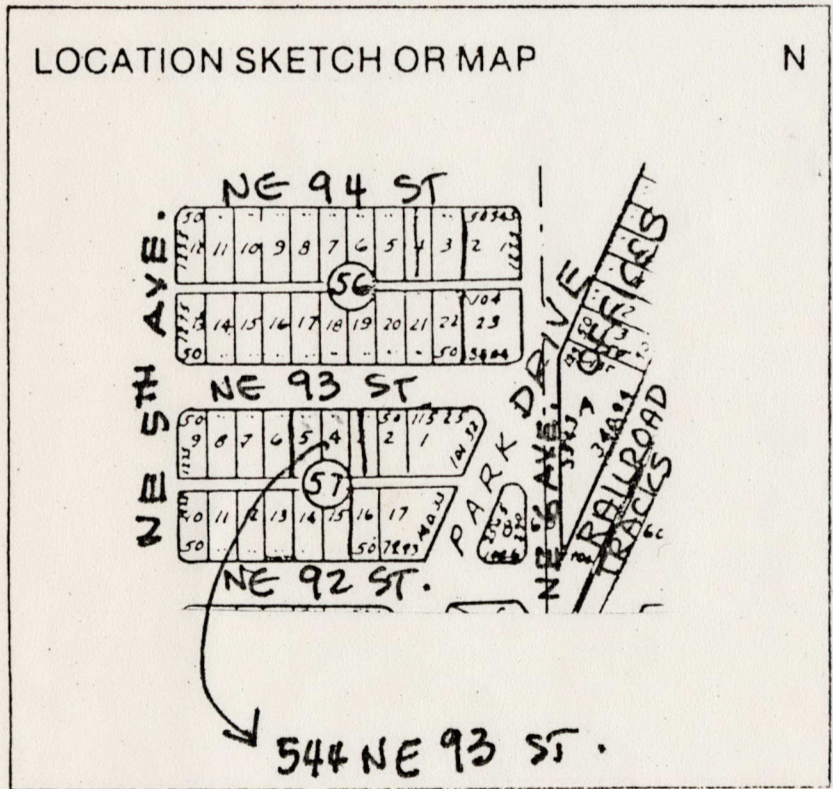

The home is one of several of English design built during the second phase of Miami Shores' development under the New Miami Shores Company.

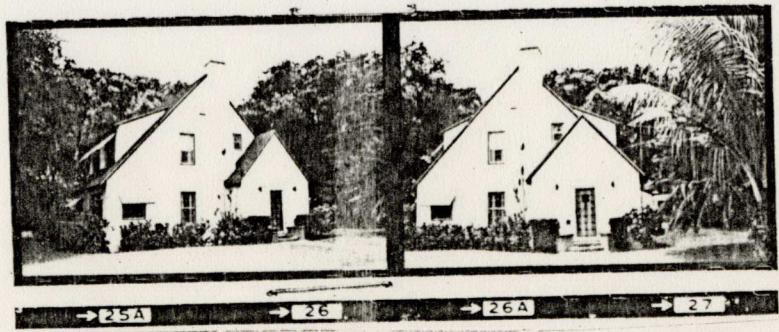

Physical Description:

Structure is an English Cottage design residence. Steep gable roofs are covered with asphalt shingles. The entry on (S) facade, slightly offset, is surrounded by cast masonry broken pediment. A 1931 addition at rear was designed by Robert Law Weed. There is a detached one-story garage and maid's quarters at rear (N) of same design and construction. Dormers windows on main residence on E & W slopes of roof.

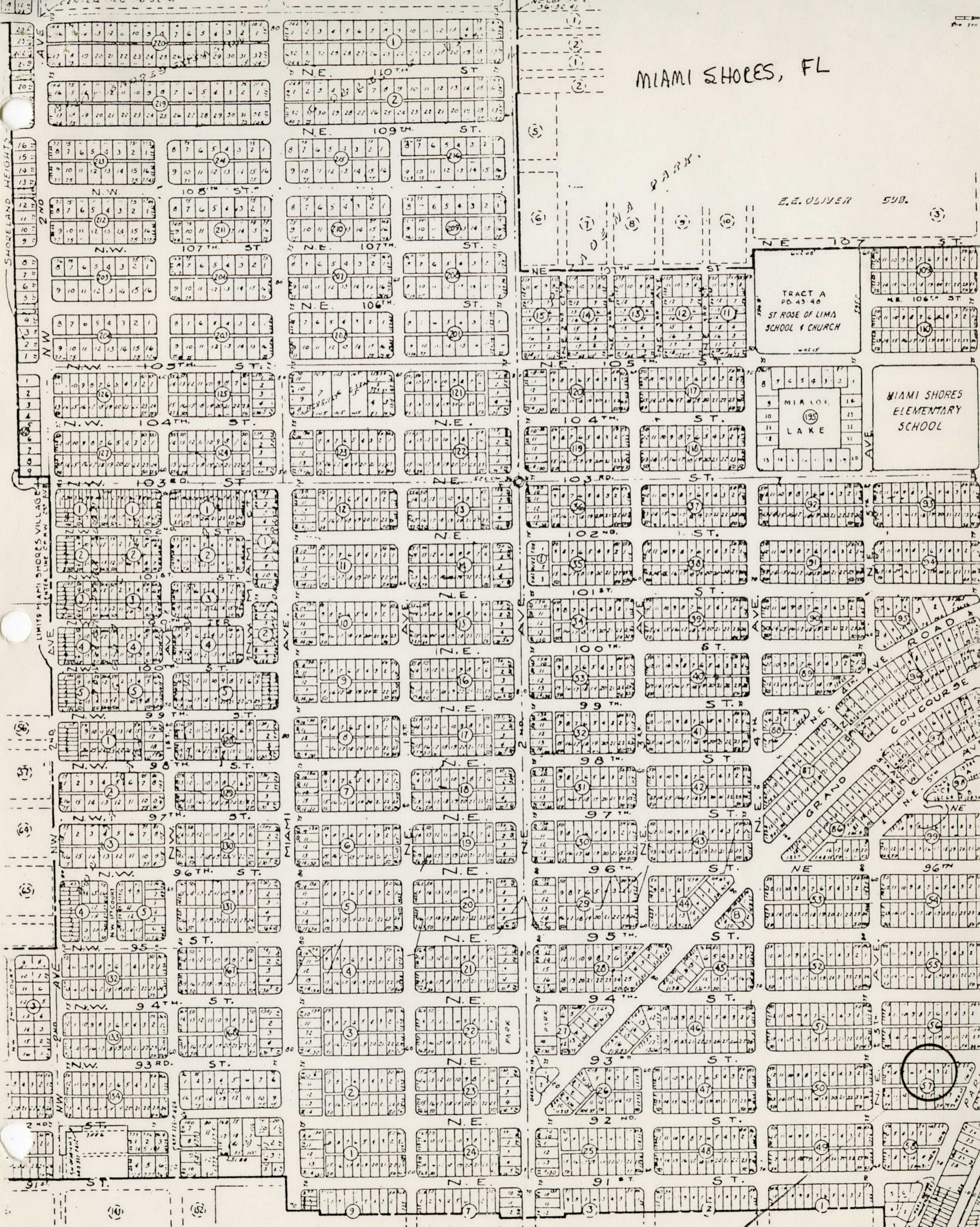
