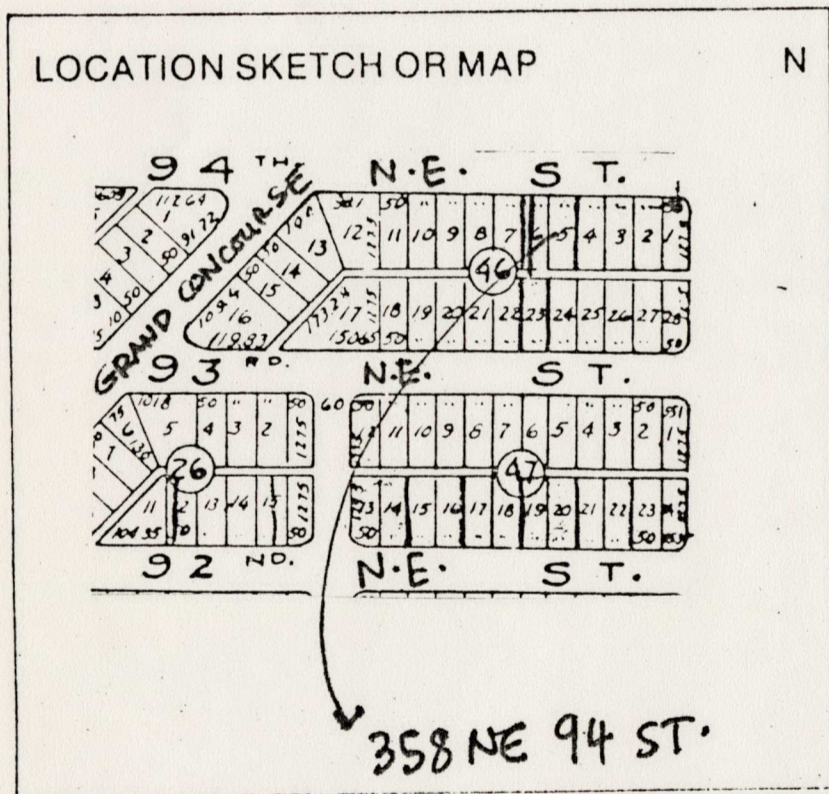

Significance:
Structure is a fine example of Mediterranean Revival architecture popular in the late 1920s second phase of Miami Shores development. The architect, Robert Law Weed, was one of the architects who helped establish the Mediterranean theme for Miami Shores. Noteworthy features include a false balconette and French doors over the main entry (N). Structure is in scale and character with surrounding neighborhood.

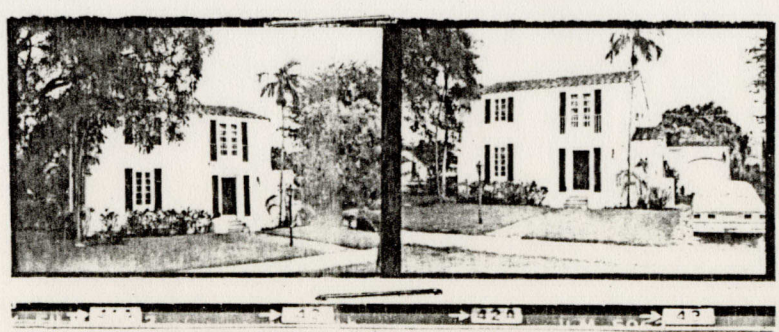

Physical Description:

Structure is a two-story Mediterranean Revival residence. Entry door (N) has applied cast masonry surround. A false masonry balconette over entry is accessed by French doors. Front (N) windows have non-functional louvered shutters. Main entry is on W side. Main structure is attached to garage by one-story addition. Garage has flat tar & gravel roof with barrel tile coping. ^{Side} Entry door has moulded door surround projecting W, with gable barrel tile roof.

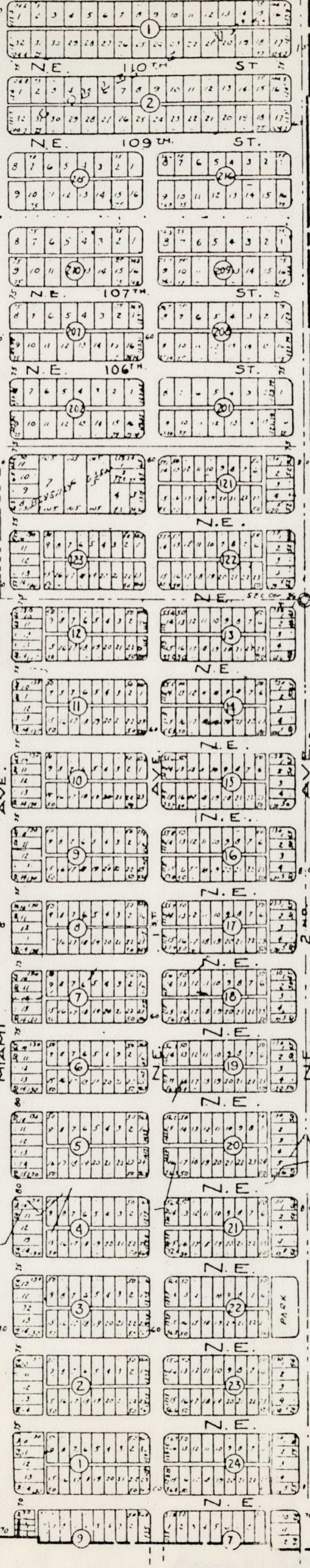
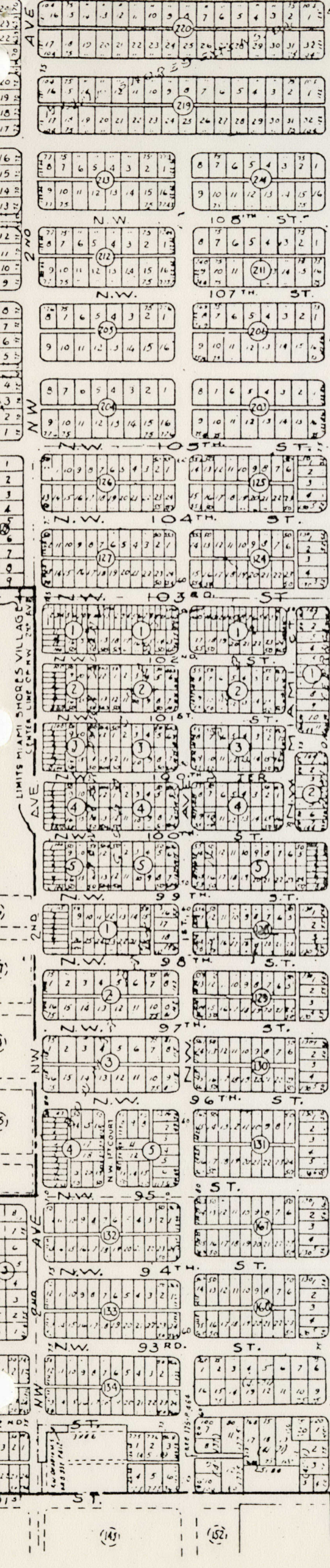
