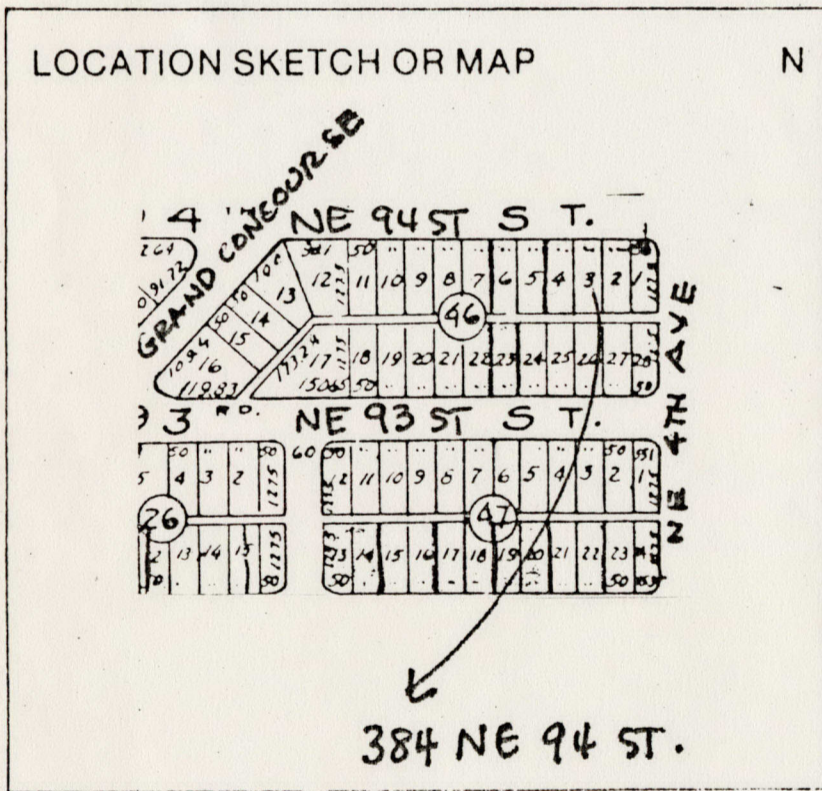

Significance:
 The home was constructed for Hugh M. Anderson, president of the Shoreland Company which developed Miami Shores. It is one of the largest homes in the community, and was built as one of several exceptional structures designed to demonstrate the quality of the project to potential buyers. Before the home was completed, the company collapsed under the financial strain resulting from the 1926 hurricane and subsequent bust of the real estate market. Anderson never occupied the home. It was the home for many years of William H. Walker whose family was prominent in Miami. The home has significant cast masonry detailing particularly on the 2nd story above the entry. It was designed by Kiehnel & Elliott, a firm that helped shape the Mediterranean theme for Miami Shores. The home is in style and character with the surrounding neighborhood. It is one of the few homes of the Shoreland development built of hollow clay tile.

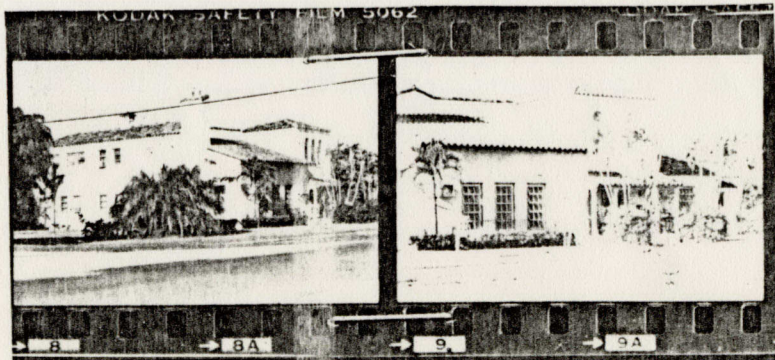

Physical Description:

Structure is an extremely large two-story Mediterranean Revival residence. A 1½ story living room forms W side of N facade. The center of N facade has a 2-story entry tower. The second story has three arched windows separated by diamond pattern pilasters with capitals of Ionic influence, and extensive cast masonry bas relief detailing. Subsequent additions have created an atrium appearance with the swimming pool in a courtyard at the rear. A detached garage on the rear (S) W of the property is of similar style and construction.
