Significance:

Structure is a good example of modified Southern Colonial style adapted to the South Florida climate. Contractor M.R. Harrison built many significant structures in Dade County was was a member of the first Miami Shores Village Council. Site is one of the earliest occupied areas of Dade County, on the coastal ridge bordering the 1856 Military Trail and is part of the 1873 Barnott Homestead. Notable features of the structure include the use of board and batten and horizontal weatherboard siding. It complements the home across the street to the N (1009 NE 94 St.) which was built at the same time.

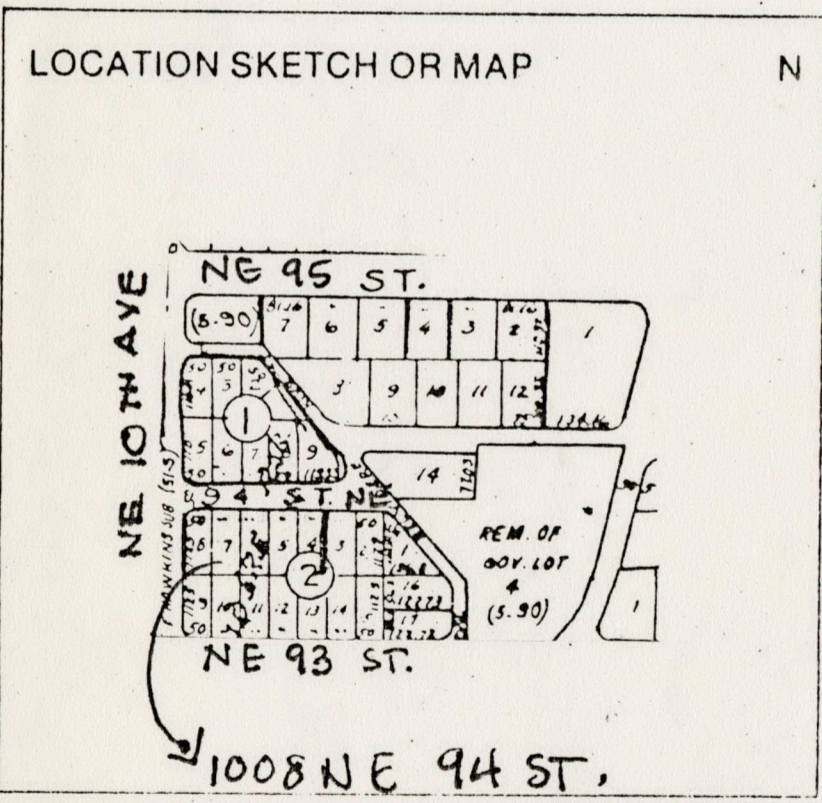

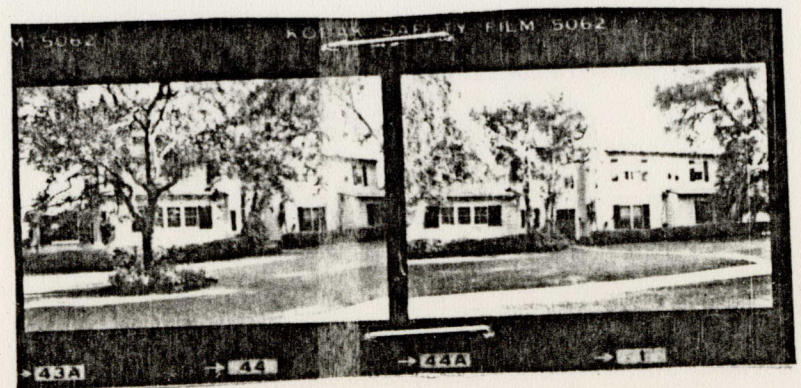

Physical Description:

Structure is two-story Southern Colonial Revival residence. A single-story addition to W has shed asphalt shingle roof; windows have non-functional board and batten shutters. Two small rooms project from central mass along with a small projecting wing on E; shed roofs. Exterior uses a combination of board & batten and horizontal weatherboard siding.
