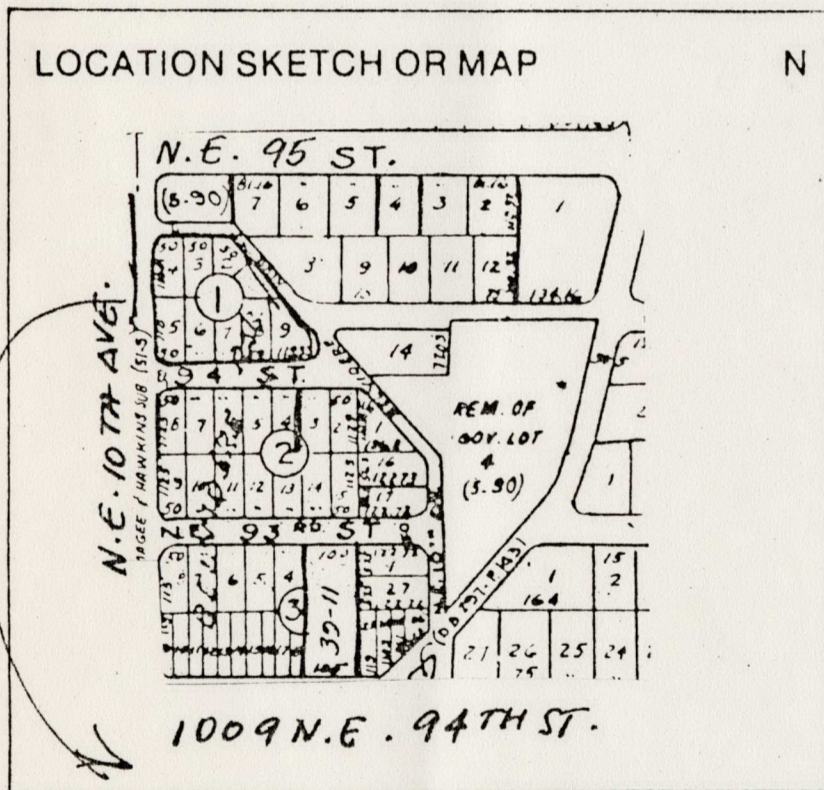
Areas of Significance: Architecture#Exploration & Settlement 910 = =

Significance:

Structure is a fine example of 1930s adaptation of Southern Colonial architecture to South Florida. Structure is significant for its combination of materials, size and proportion. Noteworthy features include a two-story entry verandah and use of copper hoods over several bay windows. Site is one of the earlier occupied areas of Dade County, on the coastal ridge bordering the 1856 Military Trail, and is part of the 1873 Barnott Homestead. A portion of the property is undisturbed. Aoolitic limerock wall bordering the N side is a significant example of pre-1920 use of native materials. The property occupies a large triangle bordered by NE 94th Street, NE 10th Avenue and Belvidere Road, which is the only remaining portion of the original road that ran through the area in the late 1800s.

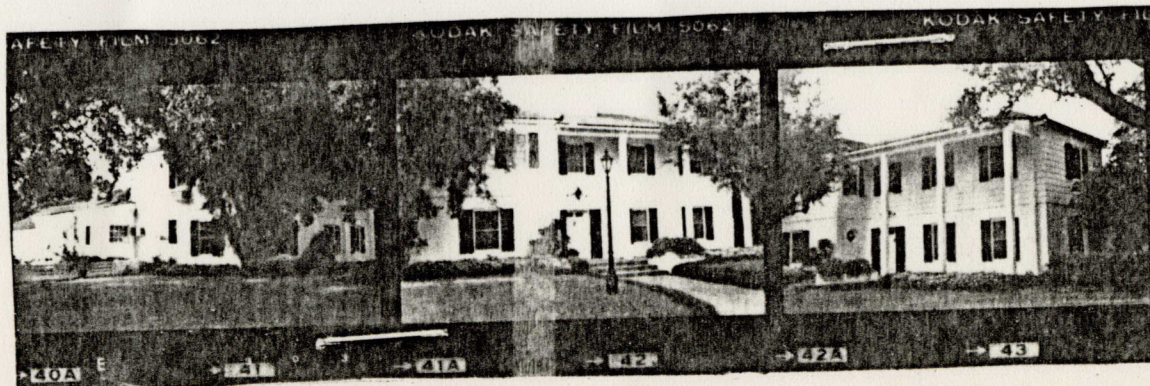

Physical Description:

Two-story Southern Colonial Revival residence with two-story entry verandah across most of S facade; wood columns. Polygonal window on E wall of W mass/W porch wall. Large bay window on E and N with copper hoods. Brick and wood fence extends from W of structure forming car park. Tennis court occupied east portion of property. Significant landscaping includes several large live oak trees. Coral rock wall borders property on Belvidere Court side. Louvered shutters on windows. Single-story garage on NW corner of property.
