

Areas of Significance: Architecture

Structure is a single-family frame vernacular home of classical design. Noteworthy features include a classical doorway with Ionic entablature on fluted pilasters. Its frame construction cannot be duplicated under present Miami Shores building codes. The home was built by George Burkel who had a number of Miami Shores home; built on speculation for investment purposes. The structure is located in an area of Miami Shores were there are a number of frame homes and is in scale and character with the neighborhood. The building site is unusually high above the street and surrounding properties.



Physical Description

Structure is a 1½-story single family home of frame construction with classically-inspired design. The building site is several feet above street level and higher than surrounding properties. The entry portico (N) is classical with Ionicentablature on fluted pilasters. Entry is French doors. Windows have wood shutters. Dentil brackets on gable ends simulate pediment. Dormers windows on the ½ story are located on the E (2) and W (2).
