
Structure is two-story masonry vernacular home constructed for Byron D. Kirby, who developed a small subdivision in Miami Shores in the 1930s. It is noteworthy for its semi-circular arched entryway and use of brick detailing. It is in scale and character with the surrounding neighborhood. Two other homes in the subdivision, 1060 and 1098 NE 95th Street, are included in this survey. William Shanklin, the architect, designed many homes in Miami Shores in the late 1930s.



### Physical Description:

Structure is a masonry vernacular residence with a two-story mass flanked by assymetrical wings, creating a significant lateral mass. Windows on 1st story of central mass and E wing have brick detail simulating shutters. Entry offset E on central mass has semi-circular arched doorway. Corbeled ornamentation on second story central mass. Porthole window on small E projection of 2nd story with porthole window. Windows without brick have wood shutters.
