Brief Description of Property: One-story, single family, CBS construction residence with barrel tile roof. Distinguishing features on front facade of house include arched window opening surrounded by cast stone bas relief, wrought iron rail, other bas relief details and use of decorative tiles.

Brief History of Property: The house was designed by L. R. Christie. It was built for Gustav Weber, Jr. It has had numerous owners throughout the years. The house is an outstanding example of Art Deco style architecture influenced by the use of Art Nouveau motifs. Specifications exist for the property in which is described the detail and care in the construction of this home and the use of a variety of materials including cast stone, wrought iron, bronze wire, glass brick, quarry tile, linoleum, etc. Many methods of construction are noted including tile work, mill work, lathing, plastering, glazing, and stucco and concrete work. The house is rich in detail both on the exterior and interior. It represents the work of a master.

At its meeting of September 30, 1996, the Historic Preservation Board passed a motion under section 11 1/2-5(b)(4) of the Miami Shores Village Code to recommend that the Village Council designate the property at 537 N.E. 96th Street, owned by Marcos Guinaldo, as an historic Landmark.

This nomination was initiated by the property owner himself under section 11 1/2-5(b)(1) of the Code, and was supported by available historic documentation (See Request for Nomination for Landmark Designation attached). The Board analyzed the general criteria for determination of structures for designation as historical landmarks found in section 11 1/2-3 of the Village Code, and found that at least one (1) of the four (4) criteria had been easily satisfied, i.e., subsections (3).

Subsection (3): Embody the distinctive characteristics of a type, period or method of construction, or that represent the work of a master, or that possess high artistic values, or that represent a significant and distinguishable entity whose component may lack individual distinction - The house is an outstanding example of Art Deco style architecture. The house represents the work of a master. It possesses distinguishing features on both the exterior and the interior. It is rich in detail and in the use of materials and methods of construction.

The owners of the property have consented to the designation, and have submitted a fully executed Historical Landmark Covenant (a covenant to run with the land), which must be recorded by the Village in the public records of Metropolitan Dade County, if the Council accepts the Board's recommendation and approves the designation, under section 11 1/2-5(b)(5).

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI SHORES VILLAGE COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY AT 537 N.E. 96TH STREET A MIAMI SHORES HISTORIC LANDMARK AND INSTRUCTING THE VILLAGE CLERK TO RECORD THE HISTORICAL LANDMARK COVENANT IN THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF METROPOLITAN DADE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, on September 30, 1996, the Historic Preservation Board, after considering the criteria for designation of historic landmarks found in section 11 1/2-3 of the Miami Shores Village Code, passed a motion, under section 11 1/2-5(b)(4), to recommend to the Village Council that the property at 537 N.E. 96th Street be designated as an historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, the current owner of the property, Marcos Guinaldo, initiated the nomination, and has consented thereto, by the execution of an Historical Landmark Covenant to run with the land; and

WHEREAS, the structure on the subject property was constructed in 1941, for Gustav Weber, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, the architect of the structure was L. R. Christie; and

WHEREAS, the subject structure is an outstanding example of Art Deco architecture as evidenced by the rich and varied use of materials, construction methods, and details;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MIAMI SHORES VILLAGE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The recitals and findings contained in the Preamble to this Resolution are hereby adopted by reference

thereto and incorporated herein as if fully set forth in this Section.

Section 2. The Miami Shores Village Council hereby accepts the recommendation of the Historic Preservation Board and approves the designation of the property at 537 N.E. 96th Street as an historic landmark of Miami Shores Village.

Section 2. The Village Clerk is hereby instructed to record the Historical Landmark Covenant, voluntarily executed and submitted to the Historic Preservation Board by the owner of the subject property, Marcos Guinaldo, in the public records of Metropolitan Dade County.
