Significance:

These masonry construction residences represent modest examples of Mediterranean architecture in Dade County around the 1920's. They are architecturally noteworthy for their stylistic features.

The residence at 568 N.E. 102nd Street was designed by renowned architect, H. George Fink. The structure was constructed by George John Inc. in 1925 at a cost of \$7,500.00. It has been the home of long time Miami Shores city manager (now retired), C. Lawton McCall, since 1933.

George Fink gained a world-wide reputation for the distinctive homes and commercial buildings he designed in Coral Gables. He was a cousin of George Merrick and first came to Miami in 1907. From 1915 to 1921 Mr. Fink designed many buildings for Carl Fisher, the major developer of Miami Beach. In 1921 he joined Merrick and designed the first homes along Coral Way. He and Merrick travelled to Spain in 1924 to study Spanish architecture. There Fink received an honorary citation from King Alphonso XIII for his work. He was associated with Coral Gables until 1928.
