Mr. Pancoast received this letter today from Senator Graham:

"Dear Mr. Pancoast:

Thanks for your interest and information you submit to me in your letter of May 26th.

The Everglades National Park appropriation bill, Senate Bill No. 707, was passed in the Senate on May 22nd. This bill appropriated \$87,760. and it is now in the House Committee, I understand. In fact, I think it has already been amended in the House. There is a chance that the Governor might cut it down as low as \$10,000. unless some work is done on him.
