the Governor assuring him the National Park Service is ready to cooperate to the fullest extent in developing the Park once the land is acquired, urging a speedy acquisition by the State of the area, when turned over to the National Park Service, urging a full and liberal appropriation to speed up the work. Also have him tell the Governor in the telegram about the million dollar item in the Presidents Budget and the one-hundred thousand dollar item as of February 4. And the possibility to use many CCC Camp men, etc. If you will please say to Mr. Cammerer that it should be done at once, it might help. Send him an air letter explaining the whole situation. And ask him to send me copy of what he sends the Governor and to give it to the press especially through the Times Union here which all members read. This might help us to get the bill through the House more speedily also. ~~We~~ might quote Mr. Ickes enthusiasm on the area also.

Tell Mr. Cammerer that I am in charge of Legislation and wish him to do this for us and that the bill has passed the Senate, yesterday the 22nd for \$87,760.

Thank you for sending me copy of the Congressional Act and copy of the article February 4, 1937 which I will distribute in the House.
