My dear Mr. Coe:

Kindly find map I am returning as per your request. I think Mr. Cammerer's idea of having error corrected is splendid. I will appreciate a new map.

Thank you very much for sending out copies of my letter to Mr. Pancoast and to Commission members. I have read Mr. Pancoast's letter to the chairman of the Senate and chairman of the House Appropriations Committee and I think it is very fine. I will do as you ask in regard to the new copy of the budget that you sent April 10 and destroy the original one you sent me. I have the thirty copies of the budget you mailed and will send them out as soon as possible to the House members I happen to know. I think we will have to realize for the present that the Legislature is not now and possibly will not in the future make any appropriation with which the Park Commission could buy lands. The state is going to feel that if they give approximately more or half of the area that the government should help Florida as much as it has helped other states for similar projects. I do believe the government is going to help us as soon as we can get straightened out which will be at once if we are going to get help.

I am sorry that Mr. Ickes and Mr. Hopkins did not permit members of Commission to entertain them.

I believe my letters to the members of the Legislature will be more effective if written on Everglades National Park Commission stationery and therefore if I could have about a hundred letter heads, a hundred plain sheets for second pages, I would appreciate it. I would like the paper at once please.
