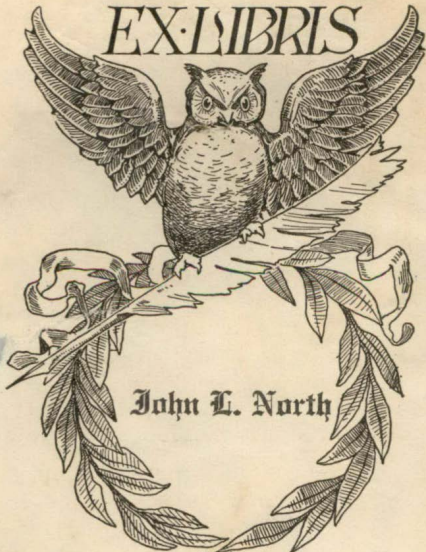

Principal Miami Physician Was Stricken Suddenly

Apparently suffered heart attack in his office &

& M. J. Flipse decreed he not be moved so
his office was turned into a hospital & he
was kept there - in great pain much of the time
Mrs. N. moved into an adjacent room.
