"Dr. Wilbur Fisk Yarborough, another Miccosukee physician was born at Milledgeville, Ga., Oct. 18, 1866. He graduated from Atlanta Medical College, Mar. 2, 1887, practiced medicine at Oxford, Ga., for two years before moving to Miccosukee, January 28, 1889, where he lived and practiced until the day of his death, Nov. 10, 1938. He was one of the most beloved of country doctors in this vicinity, as well as one of the best known for many miles around, and his son Theodore, has been a valued citizen of Tallahassee for many years."
