It gives me great pleasure to congratulate the Historic Hampton House Community Trust on the Grand Re-Opening of the Historic Hampton House.

The Hampton House Motel, as it was once stood in a part of Miami called BrownSub was not just a motel it was a special venue that drew people from the South as well as the rest of the nation. It was where people of all races came to see the best performers of that time. The Hampton House Motel featured luxurious accommodations, valet parking, 24-hour food service, a pool, banquet hall and Jazz club. It became historically important because this is where the great Martin Luther King, Malcolm X, and Muhammad Ali frequented as guests when visiting Miami, FL.

The 30,000 square foot MiMo style building will now stand fully restored to its early 60's prime state. It will have several re-created guest rooms that will serve as a museum featuring original and period style furnishings, original fictures, railings, and wall paneling, as well as the café, restaurant space and jazz club. The renovations of this facility will allow us to reminisce about the hotel that once housed the great leaders and entertainers of our society. It will bring back the memory of a place where local activist and advocates could congregate about the social ills and injustices of that day and time.

Timmy Thomas Played There

Thomas was born November 13, 1944, in Evansville, Indiana. He was one of 12 children, all of whom were musically inclined. His music education came by way of his father, a Methodist minister. Instead of hiring a pianist the Thomas children learned how to play the piano, and all spent time with the instrument on Sundays.

During his senior year in high school Thomas won a scholarship to attend Stan Kenton's Jazz clinic at Indiana University. As a result, he was then awarded a scholarship to Lane College in Jackson, Tennessee. Soon after that, Thomas signed with Goldwax records in Memphis releasing his debut single, "Have Some Boogaloo."

In 1967, Thomas graduated with a Bachelors of Art in music from Lane College. After working as an administrator at Florida Memorial College for several years, he opened up his own lounge – Timmy's Lounge in 1972. It was during this time that Thomas would find inspiration for his soon-to-be worldwide fame.

Thomas called his song "Why Can't We Live Together," because it was a reflection of all of the hatred and hurt around the world.

Thomas was able to get his record played on radio station WEDR because during certain times of the day, the station would play music by local artists who were not yet signed to major labels.

In February, 1973 "Why Can't We Live Together" reached number one R&B and number three Pop on Billboards singles charts. It went on to sell six million copies, and was nominated for a Grammy award. Throughout the 1970's Thomas continued to have chart success with songs such as "People Are Changin," "What Can I Tell Her," and "I've Got To See You Tonight."
