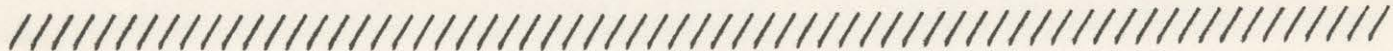
Library Report

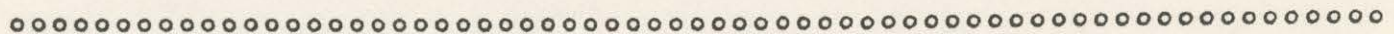


The Norton Report

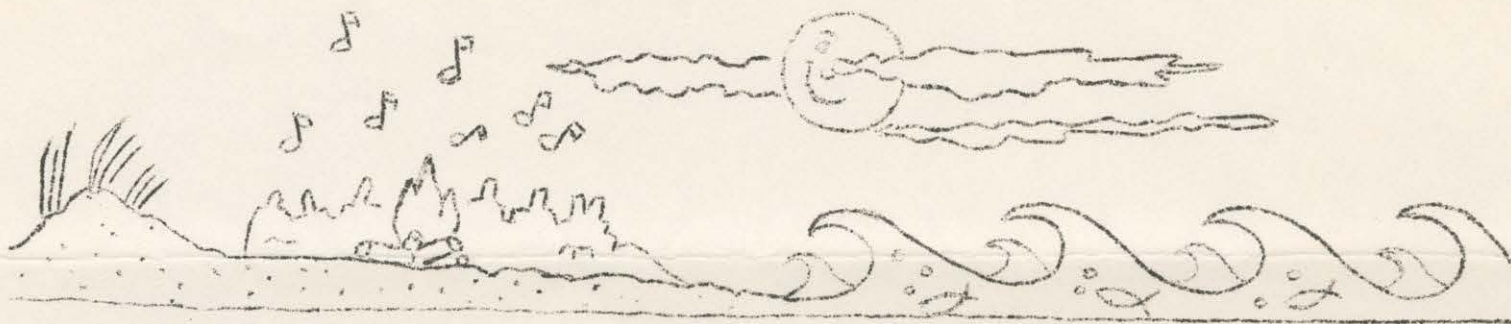
