
Dear Mr. Carr:

I am assisting the Arch Creek Trust, inc. in their efforts to preserve and enhance the National register Arch Creek site through the preservation of the above-referenced public Right of Way. As we discussed on the telephone today, I have had a meeting with the City of North Miami Beach attorneys and numerous phone calls with them subsequent to the January historic designation of the ROW. I have enclosed copies of letters documenting the status of a proposed resolution of the significant access problems created by the proposed plan for redevelopment of the abutting properties supported by the City of North Miami Beach referned in the Appeal.

I have also enclosed an article which appeared in The Miami Herald, Neighbors Section, January 26, 1995 entitled " Arch creek project runs into historic road block". In addition, I have discussed the issue of the maintenance of the ROW which the City may not be willing to maintain.
