



In connection with the captioned and confirming our conversation, I have been advised by Maureen Harwitz that the Appeal which I filed on behalf of Edna Ben-Zvi, the surviving widow of Jeremiah Ben-Zvi, has been set for hearing before the Dade County Commission on April 4, 1995.

The purpose of this letter is to advise that I will be out of the State of Florida beginning April 1, 1995 and will not return until April 10, 1995. Accordingly, I must request that a continuance be granted in that I am the only individual in my office who has the background and information necessary to represent my client in this matter.

It is my understanding that you will request a continuance of this matter. If in fact a sixty (60) day period within which the Appeal must be heard cannot be met as a result of this continuance, then the undersigned hereby waives the requirement that the Appeal be heard within that period of time.
