
At last night's meeting of the Arch Creek Trust in Arch Creek Park, some Board Members brought up the disturbing fact that the North Miami Beach entrance to the historical Military Trail is being encroached upon by the abutting business enterprises, despite the clear understanding reached with the City of North Miami Beach and the adjacent property owners that existing access to the Park will be preserved to allow access from Biscayne Boulevard by school buses.
