WHEREAS, the Historic Arch Creek Road encompasses a portion of the old County Road and Dixie Highway; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Arch Creek Road is located at: that portion of the County Rock Road (Old Dixie Highway) as the same is shown on the Amended Plat of R.E. McDonald's Subdivision Plat Book 2, at page 22, of the Public Records of Dade county, Florida, which lies South of the prolongation West of the North Iine of Lot 50 and North of the Northeasterly bank of Arch Creek as both are shown on the said plat of R.E. McDonald's Subdivision AND that strip of land lying between the County Rock Road (Old Dixie Highway) and the F.E.C.R.R. Right-of-Way which is bounded on the South by the Northeasterly bank of Arch Creek all as shown on the said plat of R.E. McDonald's Subdivision.

AND
The Dixie Highway Right-of-Way, as shown in Plat Book 15, Page 3, being 40 feet wide and extending northward in section 24, township 52 South, Range 42 East.
