Nature Photography Workshop - November 19

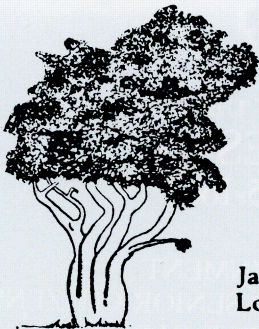
