Gables Will Vote On High Risers

Coral Gables 'Equalizes' Golf Fees

Golf fees at the Granada and Biltmore Golf Courses were "equalized" by the Coral Gables City Commission Tuesday.

Henceforth, all residents, whether members of the Coral Gables Country Club or not, will pay the same fees.

A disparity will still exist, however, between non-resident members of the Country Club and other non-residents.

Commissioner Joe Murphy moved the legislation last week after a group of golfers, led by attorney Bernard Weksler, sued the city, charging that fees at the two municipally operated courses were discriminatory.

Commissioners agreed that the fee structure should be reviewed at the next budget session to determine if any changes should be made.

The change will result in a minor loss in revenue to the city between now and the end of the fiscal year.

Meanwhile, City Attorney Ted Semple filed a motion in Circuit Court to have the suit dismissed.

Two men were struck and hospitalized by buses emerging from the Coral Gables bus terminal within two days.

Clifton R. Bortorff, 56, of 3721 SW LeJaune Rd., struck on Aragon Jan. 21, is reported in "fair" condition at Doctors' Hospital. He had been "critical".

Samuel Randall, 72, of 713 Minorca, was struck at the Giralda exit Jan. 23. He is listed in "good" condition at Doctors' Hospital.


Bortorff suffered head, hand and leg injuries. Randall suffered severe lacerations of the head and other lacerations of the knees and hands.

The younger victim was struck or walked into the side of the emerging bus shortly after 5 p.m. Saturday.

Driver of the bus was identified as William Austin Leverington, 42, of 10340 SW 35th Ter. He was not charged with the accident.

Randall was hit at approximately the same time Monday by a bus driven by William Wright, 38, of 6120 SW 28th St. The bus was emerging from the Giralda end of the terminal.

The driver said he stopped the bus at the exit and that the elderly man walked in front of the bus and was hit as the bus started up again.

Issue To Be Placed On April 11 Ballot

The question of high rise apartment buildings in Coral Gables appears to be heading for a referendum in the April 11 municipal election.

Commissioners agreed Tuesday to put the highly controversial question to the people after Commissioner Joe Murphy said he intended to introduce a resolution to that affect next week.

City Attorney Ted Semple was instructed to get together with attorney Franklin Parson to put the referendum question in legal form to present to the people. Parson was active in combating a recent high rise proposal.

Murphy proposes to amend the City Charter if the people decide to limit or block future high rise apartment structures.

The referendum questions, as proposed by Murphy, would ask the voters to indicate:

- No high rise apartment

structures under any circumstances.

- Permitting unrestricted construction of high rise apartments in all existing areas zoned for apartments.

- Permitting high rise apartments only under the following limitations:

- After a public hearing on the proposal.

- Notification to neighboring property owners living within a 750 to 1000-foot radius.

- Upon a four-fifths vote of the City Commission if between 10 and 20 percent of property owners object.

- On two readings of an ordinance with a 30-day period before it goes into effect.

- And subject to present and future zoning ordinances governing setbacks, architecture, landscaping.

Mayor John M. Montgomery and Commissioner Robert Searle, who recently backed construction of a high rise apartment building at 720 Biltmore Way, went along with Murphy on his referendum proposal.

"It would clear the air," said Montgomery.

"It should not be a campaign issue," he said, adding that he would not be a candidate for re-election.

Commissioner Searle, who has not revealed his political plans, said he had "no objections" to Murphy's proposal.

Commissioner Frank Kerdyk, who voted with Murphy and Commissioner James Hess to revoke the "skyscraper" apartment resolution permitting A. H. Sakolsky to build, was absent from the meeting.

Murphy Tuesday also brought up the permit issued to Sakolsky for construction of the controversial building's foundation.

City Attorney Ted Semple told the Commission that the previous action revoking permission to build also nullified the permit.

Meanwhile, a new organization, still without a name, was created at the Youth Center Friday when approximately 100 residents met to discuss the high rise problem and zoning restrictions.

They named a 17-man board of directors but put off electing a leader until a future meeting.

They also called for a referendum on the high rise question.

The group met under the auspices of the Committee for the Preservation of Present Zoning Ordinances, active in the fight against the Biltmore high riser.

Gables To Keep School Guards

The Coral Gables City Commission decided last week to keep its school crossing guards—at least until Metro comes through with installation of protective lights.

City Manager L. W. Robinson Jr. recommended retention of the guards.

"It's just another service to Coral Gables residents," Robinson told the Commission.

Most Dade County municipalities have abolished the guards after installation of crosswalk lights. Hialeah recently indicated that they were using both.

Robinson is to learn from Metro when they plan to install the lights in the Gables.

All State Reading Band members are Barbara Mathews, first chair, first flute; Judy Blume, second chair, first flute; Vicki Kapplow, first chair, first oboe.

All State Concert Orchestra woodwind members auditioned months in advance. They are Marianne Ankrum, first chair, first flute; Dennis Koger, first chair, second horn.

All the groups were on a televised program on Jan. 14. Judy Blume appeared with the read-

ing band, performing the flute solo, (with accompaniment of the band) Concertino by Chaminate, for the band directors present.

Richard Ginn and Dennis Koger were auditioned and offered scholarships to Stetson University.

Five flute players from Gables all made firsts and competed against each other.

Curtis Mosso, who swam on the Gables High Varsity last year, has continued participating in this sport in college. Yale

University recently reported on his excellence in swimming with that college's Freshman team. Swimming is one of the 15 intercollegiate sports in which Yale students participate during the year.

Mosso, who was a member of National Honor Society while at Gables, was selected as a member of the All-American freestyle relay team last year.

A South Miami resident since 1904, Mrs. Barrs came here from Lownes County, Ga. Her husband, who died in 1943, owned the first grocery store and later the first dry goods store in South Miami. The store was at the intersection of what is now Sunset Dr. and SW 59th Pl.

First Postmaster

Her husband later was the first postmaster.

Survivors include six sons and five daughters, most of whom still reside in the Miami area. Surviving sons include Raymond E., John P., Oren M., Gordon A. and R. Grady, all of Dade County, and William K., of San Francisco.

Surviving daughters include

Mrs. Amy E. Arnold, Mrs. Adel E. Deckham and Mrs. Ruby A. Ricks, all of Dade County, and Mrs. Leola E. Petrarca, of Union City, N. J., and Mrs. Eva B. Catlett, of Crescent City, Fla.

There are 31 surviving grandchildren and 27 great grandchildren.

She was a member of the Miami Pioneers Club and First Baptist Church of South Miami.

Sons Served

According to her son, Grady, the family resided until 1956 in a two-story home in the 5900 block of Sunset Dr. Six of her sons served in World War II. They all survived.

When she and her husband came to South Miami there were less than 100 here. South Miami was then known as Larkins.

Most of the customers for his grocery store were Seminole Indians. There were no roads to Miami. But one could peddle a bicycle to Coconut Grove and from there take a boat to Miami.

Ancillary is the word being used repeatedly in stories about the expected income for the March 13 Patterson-Johansson fight for the world heavyweight championship in the Miami Beach Convention Hall.

Webster's dictionary explains the meaning of ancillary as "... serving as an aid, accessory or secondary."

To Feature Sports, Inc., the New York City firm promoting the fight, there's nothing secondary about the ancillary rights to the event.

The "live" gate at Convention Hall could be as high as \$1,100,000 if all the \$100, \$50, and \$20 tickets are purchased but the ancillary rights (closed-circuit TV, movies, radio, etc.) may be near \$4,000,000.

Roy Cohn, a director of Feature Sports, predicted recently that the fight would gross \$5,000,000 from all sources.

And there's nothing secondary about four million dollars.

The second Patterson-Johansson fight grossed close to \$3,500,000 with the radio rights this time being almost double that of the 1960 Polo Grounds battle.

The TelePrompter Corp. of New York City actually owns all the ancillary rights to the fight save those for the Scandinavian countries which are controlled by Ingemar Johansson, the Swedish challenger.

The radio rights alone were sold by TelePrompter to ABC for \$300,000. Feature Sports is to receive 15 per cent of the ancillary rights.

Actually the word ancillary comes from ancile, a coin of the Antonious Pius era of ancient Rome.

Old Pius never dreamed what he started with his ancile.
