# New Elementary School Approved

## Coral Way, 82nd Avenue Will Get Traffic Light

A new traffic light will be erected at the intersection of Coral Way and SW 82nd Ave. by Metro.

The intersection—which took the lives of two motorists Nov. 5 when their cars plunged into the canal paralleling Coral Way—has been the scene of hundreds of other accidents in recent years.

Joseph Mantinan, who lives at the intersection and who helped lead the recent fight to get greater protection, said last week the light will help, but more should be done.

### Main Thoroughfare

Mantinan said that SW 82nd Ave., which is a main thoroughfare for north-south traffic in the area, is dangerously narrow where it bridges the canal.

Race track traffic when Tropical Race Track is open makes the situation at the intersection even more dangerous.

Mantinan said that the dangerous condition will not be corrected until the canal is covered and SW 82nd Ave. is widened to four lanes to handle its heavy traffic.

### Palmetto Expressway

The Palmetto Expressway, rapidly nearing completion in that area, will take a load off SW 82nd Ave., but lack of other main thoroughfares make that road appear destined to bear a heavy load of traffic.

## Liquor License Flood Expected In South Miami

Expecting a flood of liquor license applications, South Miami Council Tuesday night did what it could to limit the issuance of such licenses.

Council passed on first and second reading an ordinance amending its Code of Ordinances section on liquor licenses by establishing the location of liquor establishments in relation to churches and schools.

Expecting at least two new liquor stores or bars in the city due to the 1960 census, the city fathers set a distance of 500 feet that bars or stores must be from schools or churches.

City Attorney George B. Hardie Jr. advised Council that the location and the opening and closing times were the only regulations the city had over such licenses.

### In other business, Council:

## Will Relieve Pressure At Other Schools

Construction of a new South Dade elementary school, to relieve student pressure at two other schools, will begin about Jan. 1, according to Dade County School Board officials.

South Palmetto Elementary, slated to cost about \$375,000, will be constructed on a nine-acre tract at SW 136th St. and SW 77th Ave. following opening of bids on the job Dec. 21.

### Relieve Elementaries

The building is planned to relieve student pressure at Palmetto and Coral Reef Elementaries.

According to Architect John M. Lyell, of Miami, plans for the new school are those formerly used for the construction of Coral Reef Elementary, which is being used for the first time during the current school year.

The new plant will include 20 classrooms, a library, cafeteria, administration facilities and a teachers' lounge.

"With a few minor changes," Architect Lyell said, "we are using the Coral Reef Elementary plans.

"Since its cost about \$360,000 for the Coral Reef job, we are estimating cost of the new school at \$375,000," he added.

The building is expected completed by July 14 and ready for use by the beginning of school in the fall.

## UM To Give Evening Courses At Cutler Ridge

University of Miami will soon open an Evening Division at Cutler Ridge Regional Shopping Center.

Developers Joshua J. Segal and David Blumberg made the announcement this week following negotiations with the University, which will bring evening classes to Cutler Ridge beginning Feb. 6.

Initially, two departments of the University will conduct the classes. These are the Music and Art Departments. Following are the two courses as they will be listed in the regular bulletins of the University, AE 255, listening to Music, non-credit, Tuesday only, 7:30 - 9 p.m.; AE 172, Looking at Painting, non-credit, Thursday only, 7:30 - 9 p.m.

Students may register by mail. The fee is \$25.

# Who Really Owns The Old Gables Youth Center Tract?

Actual ownership of the former Coral Gables Youth Center property remains clouded as the principals involved refuse to reveal details about the controversial piece of property used by the city for off street parking.

The City Commission Tuesday decided to look into the matter following the appearance of attorney Bernard B. Weksler, who charged that the city is being "used" and development of the block-long property is being stymied through a tax forgiveness agreement with the owner.

Weksler said Tuesday that the County is also losing valuable taxes through the arrangement. Weksler also questioned the validity of the agreement itself since the owner of record and reported ownership are in conflict.

### Can't Find Answer

"I haven't been able to find an answer to that," Weksler told the Commission.

Weksler said he searched city, county and state records—all indicating that Florida National

Realty Co., Inc., which purchased the property from the War Memorial Youth Association and the City for \$351,600, was and still is the owner of record.

But the agreement to use the property for off street parking in lieu of taxes was made with James Sottile Jr., who presented himself as the owner on Nov. 1, 1958.

"I feel that the city has been used . . . and it's time the city not be used," Weksler told the Commission.

The 10-year lease in reality is a 30-day lease, since the lease is cancellable on 30-days notice from either party, he said.

Mayor John M. Montgomery questioned Weksler on his motives for opposing the lease.

### Opposes Lease

Weksler told Montgomery he opposed the lease because it stopped development of the property and resulted in a tax loss of \$5000 to \$6000 to the county.

The discussion then turned to City Attorney Ted Semple, who negotiated the lease.

"The property is owned by James Sottile Jr.," Semple told Weksler emphatically.

Semple said he negotiated the off street parking lease with Sottile's attorneys and that he would take their word that Sottile owned the property.

"I have never placed the city in jeopardy," Semple said.

Weksler and Semple then squared off on the motives for the 10-year lease, with Weksler charging that it was a gimmick to provide tax exemption and Semple countering that it was necessary to make the agreement legal and binding.

Semple said that the 40 percent off street parking requirement was blocking development and not speculation.

Weksler said he had written to Florida National Realty Co., Inc. to determine if they owned the property.

The firm gave him a 'mind your own business' type of answer, and questioned his reason for wanting to know, Weksler indicated.

(Wednesday, Weksler said he received another reply from the Jacksonville DuPont firm telling him that they did not feel free

to give out any information without Sottile's consent).

### What's Bothering You?

"I don't understand what is bothering you about the ownership of the property," Commissioner Frank Kerdyk told Weksler at Tuesday's meeting.

"I don't think it behooves the city to be engaged in a lease with a person who doesn't own the land," Weksler replied.

"Do you think we should spend \$200,000 to buy property . . . ?" Montgomery asked Weksler.

Montgomery estimated it would cost this much to replace the temporary parking facility being used by the city in exchange for taxes.

"I have no objections to the city entering into a bona fide contract with the bona fide owner," Weksler told Montgomery.

"Let us take the matter under advisement," the mayor said.

Meanwhile, Sottile told the TIMES Wednesday that he is the owner of the property, but declined to make any other clarifying statement for publication.

Fred Hartnett, mayor of Coral Gables at the time the old Youth Center tract was sold to Florida National Realty Co., Inc., had some comment on the TIMES story when questioned about the ownership.

Hartnett, who, according to a letter on file with the city from Sottile to former city manager Ira Willard, bought the land from Sottile, charged that last week's TIMES story about the

property and ownership was "subjective."

"What difference does it make who owns it?" said the former mayor. "What a man does with his property is his business," Hartnett added.

"I am not the owner of the property," said Hartnett.

Who initiated the proposal that the land be used by the city for off street parking?

### TIMES Story

A TIMES story dated April 4, 1957, reported that a spokesman for Sottile had announced that the property was available to the city for any purpose it cared to use it for. This followed a long controversy over removal of the old Youth Center building.

"Since we purchased the land last year, it has been Mr. James Sottile's understanding that the city may use it for any purpose that would not interfere with eventual building on it," the unidentified spokesman was quoted as saying.

Willard, who was city manager at the time, said he had no recollection of a formal offer being made by Sottile at that time.

It was his recollection, Willard said, that he approached Sottile on the off street parking proposal before the lease agreement was negotiated with Semple in 1958 following a meeting of the Traffic and Parking Committee of the Chamber of Commerce.

"No, I'm not interested," Willard quoted Sottile as saying when he was contacted about the plan.

Later, Willard said, Sottile agreed to go along.

"I considered he was the owner. I had no reason to doubt," Willard said.

### Attorney's Responsibility

Determination of ownership is the city attorney's responsibility, Willard pointed out.

On Nov. 1, 1958, the agree-

ment was signed between the city and Sottile. The city was to pay "rent" equivalent to the taxes and negotiated to have the county forgive taxes.

Has it been and is it a good deal?

Weksler, pointing to the tax loss to the county, alleged loss of parking meter revenue, slow up of development and subsequent added tax loss claims it isn't.

Those who favor the arrangement point to revenue to the city over the tax loss and provision of parking to employees, employers and others in the downtown area as a plus.

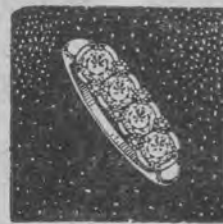
### Students Can't Sell From Door To Door

**Gablelite Bases Book On Christ, His Teachings**

The gap between architect and author may sound formidable to some, but not to Dr. Upton Clary Ewing, 362 Min-orca Ave.

Dr. Ewing, a member of The American Institute of Architects and designer of many buildings here including the Fuller and Parsons Buildings, is the author of a new religious book "The Essene Christ".

The book, which is the result of over five years of intense research into the historical background of early Christianity, deals with the relationship between Christ and His teachings and the ancient Essene sect from Judea.

**Four Parts**

The work is divided into four parts, or books and contains recent discoveries from the Dead Sea Scrolls. Dr. Ewing considers "The Essene Christ" to be must reading for every Christian.

Interviewed at the Ewing Gallery, in Coral Gables, the doctor confided that he alternates his house slippers between feet because it allows the heels to wear down more evenly.

**Paintings, Sculpture**

The Ewing Gallery, which is built around a secluded patio and pond, features paintings and sculpture by the doctor and a large organ that his wife, Loris, plays for concerts. This year the

Ewings plan to have Christmas entertainment at the Gallery.

Dr. Ewing is also a Metaphysician associated with the International New Thought Alliance and an ordained minister whose religion teaches that all men are sons of God and members of a great universal brotherhood.

"The Essene Christ" will soon be available at local book stores.

Held at the Miracle Theater, the half-hour meeting drew men and women from all phases of the community's life, with a heavy concentration of local business and professional leaders.

Said Robert Hildreth, chairman of the special supervising committee on publicity and advertising:

"The city's aim is to do for business what it can't do for itself."

That aim, City Publicity Director Bert Burris, will be pinpointed at persuading people that Coral Gables is the ideal place to spend a day, week or lifetime.

Specially prepared slides of newspaper advertisements and recordings of commercials to be presented on radio were shown by Karl Bishopric and Jack Green of Bishopric, Green, Fielden, Inc.

The advertisements and commercials are designed for general appeal and to create a desire to shop, work and live in Coral Gables.

Another \$25,000 appropriated by the City Commission to finance the Coral Gables Open Tournament is being handled directly by the City and will be largely self liquidating, Burris told the group.

### National Publicity

The tournament, arranged in cooperation with the Professional Golf Association, should bring a great deal of national publicity, Burris said.

# Father's Day Cake Is Holiday Fare

They celebrate Father's Day a dozen times a year at the Al Marx home, every time Gerrie Marx serves her husband and three children their favorite chocolate frosted devil's food cake.

"We call it Father's Day Cake, because I first baked it for that occasion 10 years ago. Now it is such a favorite that we have it at least once a month," said the pretty homemaker. She is the mother of Don, 12; Janis, 9; and Gail, 5.

In her pink and aqua kitchen at 1715 SW 83rd Ct., Gerrie prepares some 1095 meals a year, spending about one-fifth of her days in the kitchen. Yet she has never lost her enthusiasm for cooking. She keeps a recipe clipping file, a well-thumbed row of cookbooks and tries new dishes regularly to avoid monotony. Raised in the North but now a confirmed Southerner, her cooking combines the best from both areas.

Today, Gerrie Marx is an excellent cook but this was not always true. When she married insurance agent Al Marx 13 years ago, Gerrie could not cook at all.

She remembers one dreadful day when she had struggled to bake a birthday cake for her mother. She placed it, beautifully frosted, in the kitchen window to cool. A strong breeze whipped the curtain and down when the cake into the dishwasher in the sink below.

So she tried again. This time, there was no chocolate so she substituted cocoa. The cake was like rubber but her mother ate it with a brave smile.

Steak is the favorite food, although Al is almost as fond of liver and onions. Like most homemakers, Gerrie has to argue that vegetables be eaten. But in one case—spinach—she has found a dish that always brings the children back for more. She takes ground meat, frozen spinach, macaroni and white sauce and cooks them separately, then combines them in a casserole with seasonings. Finally, it is browned in the oven. "It takes time but it's really delicious," said Gerrie.

Birthdays and other happy events call for a home-baked pie or cake. Frozen rolls and biscuits get Gerrie's approval, but she mixes her own cakes and pie crusts. Luckily, she enjoys baking because the family always expects a dessert.

The most cherished appliance of this good cook is her home freezer. Buying on a budget, she takes advantage of sales to buy food in quantities and freeze it. When baking, she usually doubles the recipe, serving one pie or cake and freezing the other. School lunches are prepared ahead and frozen. Shortening cans are saved and used for storing food in the freezer.

The five Marxes take part in many activities and cooking usually comes into the picture. Gerrie bakes cakes for PTA

meetings; cookies for her children's youth group; covered dishes for the dinners at a square dance club she and Al attend twice a month.

High spots on the family calendar are their popular barbecue dinners, served informally, when guests enjoy chicken that bubbles with fragrant juices, so tender it almost falls from the bone.

The chicken is cooked over charcoal for about 1½ hours, turned regularly and basted with the special Marx sauce. The couple experimented with many barbecue sauces before they found this combination, which they consider a perfect blend of flavors:

#### Marx Barbecue Sauce

- 1 cup catsup
- 2 T. vinegar
- 2 T. Worcester sauce
- ½ teaspoon Tobasco
- ½ cup chopped onion
- 1 teaspoon dry mustard
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup water
- ¼ lb. margarine (or ½ cup cooking oil)

Bring to boil; simmer 10 minutes; keep warm till used.

#### Father's Day Cake

- ¾ cup shortening
- 2¼ cups sifted cake flour
- 1¾ cups sugar
- 1½ teaspoon soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1½ cups sour milk or butter-

milk (or use 1½ table-  
spoons vinegar

- 2 squares melted chocolate
- 2 eggs
- Nuts and red coloring

Place shortening in bowl. Sift flour, sugar, soda, salt in bowl. Add vanilla and 1 cup sour milk. Beat 2 minutes. Add melted chocolate, eggs, rest of sour milk. Beat 2 minutes. Add nuts and few drops of red coloring. Line pans with waxed paper and bake at 375 degrees 30 min. or until cake springs back when touched with finger.

#### Chocolate Nut Frosting

- 4 squares unsweetened chocolate
- ¾ cups brown sugar
- ¾ cup butter (¾ of ¾-lb. stick)
- 1-3 cup water
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 2 cups sifted confection. sugar
- 2 egg yolks, unbeaten

¾ teaspoon vanilla

Combine chocolate, sugar, butter, water and salt in saucepan. Stir over medium heat till chocolate and butter melt. Simmer 2-3 minutes or till slightly thick, stirring occasionally. Cool 5 minutes. Add confectioner's sugar gradually, beating after each addition. Add egg yolks and vanilla. Beat well. Use for filling and frosting cake.

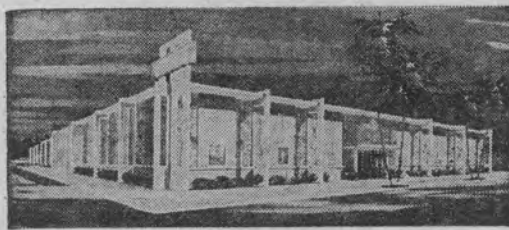

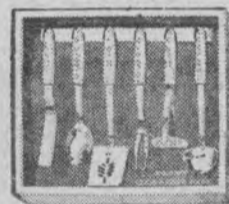

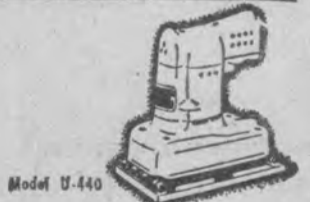

## McDonald Chain Boasts World's Fastest Meal

The world's fastest restaurant service is claimed by the McDonald's drive-in chain, which has a unit here in Miami at 3145 NW 7th St. A meal of a hamburger plus French fried potatoes and triple-thick milkshake is prepared in an average time of 90 seconds, reports Don Lehn, who operates the local McDonald's.

"Our system of service is as meticulously worked out as a Detroit production line," Lehn says. "And like Detroit, we insist on quality as well as speed in service."

McDonald's units turn out an average of 70,000 burgers and 31,000 shakes a month and as high as 1700 orders of French fries in a day.

"Uniformity in food preparation pays off in low prices for our customers," says Don.

Lehn notes: "Our self-service policy is the basic factor of our quick meal. The customer never has to wait for carhop to take his order, bring his tray, and collect his check."

Orders are taken at a window in the plate glass wall of the drive-in directly from the customer, who carries his sandwiches to his car or home.

No carhops are employed and no person may enter the food preparation area except the operator and employees.
