FOUNDING MEMBER, MERLE VAUGHT, PASSES AWAY


Merle Vaught, one of the founding members of the Greater North Miami Historical Society passed away on June 4, 1998. He was 74 years old and had contributed to North Miami in many ways.

As the 9th President of the North Miami Jaycees, Merle worked to build the Jaycee Hall, located at 12100 West Dixie Highway, and was in fact installed as president at the very first meeting in the building in the early 1950s. He was also active in city politics.

Merle was always aware that it is important for a group to hold on to its history. He donated to the Jaycees several scrapbooks he had kept of the group's activities during the 50s, 60s, and 70s.

For the GNMHS, he had taken during the past year the lead in contacting various civic clubs in our area to ask for their stories and historical notes.

Merle Vaught was a gentleman and a staunch community activist. We will all miss him greatly


