OPERATIONAL SERVICES UNIT ELECTION The Public Employees Relations Commission (PERC) has approved a consent election agreement between the State of Florida, the State Coalition of Public Employees (SCOPE) and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME).

PERC will mail ballots to the homes of the Unit employee at the address on the election eligibility list. Employee will have five weeks to return ballot to PERC.

Only those unit employees who were employed as of March 30, 1978 biweekly, and March 31, 1978 monthly are eligible to vote.

CREDIT UNION INFORMATION
A STEADY RISE IN THE COST OF MAINTAINING SHARE ACCOUNTS MADE IT MANDATORY FOR THE DIRECTORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI CREDIT UNION TO ESTABLISH THE FOLLOWING POLICIES:

- 1) MEMBERS ON THE UNIVERSITY PAYROLL, WHO DO NOT HAVE A LOAN ACCOUNT WITH THE CREDIT UNION, MUST MAINTAIN A MINIMUM SHARE BALANCE OF \$50.00.
- 2) MEMBERS, <u>NO LONGER</u> ON THE UNIVERSITY PAYROLL, MAY RETAIN MEMBERSHIP IN THE CREDIT UNION ONLY IF THEY MAINTAIN A MINIMUM BALANCE OF \$200,00.

A CREDIT UNION ACCOUNT MAY NOT BE USED AS A CHECKING ACCOUNT, AND PERIODIC WITH-DRAWALS WILL FORCE US TO CLOSE THE ACCOUNT.

CREDIT UNION PAYS 5 3/4% PER ANNUM ON REGULAR SAVINGS - WHY BE SATISFIED WITH LESS? START TODAY: DEPOSITS ACCEPTED BY MAIL, IN PERSON OR BY PAYROLL DEDUCTION.
