TIAA-CREF COMES TO F.I.U.

State of Florida employees have been unable to deduct premiums through payroll for membership in TIAA-CREF (Teachers Insurance and Annuity Association-College Retirement Equities Fund). This was because existing statutes required that TIAA-CREF pay a premium tax to conduct business in the state of Florida.

Legislation waiving this tax became effective on July 1, but much paperwork had to be done to make payroll deductions workable. This paperwork is now completed and payroll deduction for TIAA-CREF premiums is now possible. We have a payroll deduction code for TIAA-CREF annuities.
