ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE FOR EMPLOYEES TO BE REEXAMINED OR TREATED FOR A MILITARY SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY

Effective October 1, 1984, any
State employee who has been rated by
the Veterans Administration to (1) have
incurred a service-connected
disability, and (2) who is scheduled by
the VA to be reexamined or treated for
the disability shall be granted administrative leave for such reexamination
or treatment. In no event shall the
administrative leave under these provisions exceed 6 calendar days per yr.
