1985-86 FISCAL YEAR SALARY INCREASES FOR CAREER SERVICE EMPLOYEES

This issue of the Personnel Touch is designed to provide you with information relating to the 1985-86 Career Service salary increases. There are two types of Career Service pay increases authorized by the Legislature during the 1985-86 fiscal year: (A) Annual Salary Increase, and (B) Performance Incentive (or Merit) Increase.

A. Annual Salary Increase

The annual salary increase will be effective January 1, 1986. The salary increase guarantees a minimum of \$750.11 for every full-time Career Service employee who has an "achieves" or "exceeds" performance standards appraisal rating. However, the total annual increase amount is based on the employee's job classification and is not based on the appraisal rating. Many classifications will receive an amount greater than \$750.11.

The specific increase for each job classification can be seen on the attached list. The annual salary increase indicated is based on full-time employment. Part-time employees will receive an increase proportionate to the number of hours worked. The list shows the class titles that resulted from the December 13, 1985, Class Consolidation Project in which some class titles stayed the same, others changed and others were consolidated to a new class title.

In some cases, the pay increase for employees in the classes that were consolidated depends upon what the employee's classification was before December 13, 1985. Those classes have a "See Below" note in the "Total Pay Increase" column. Employees in those classes should refer to the "Previous Class Title" column to determine the total pay increase for their new class.

The total annual pay increase is comprised of four (4) categories of possible pay adjustment.

- Competitive Area Differential Equity Adjustment (CAD) 1. The CAD category is a special "pay additive" approved by the Department of Administration for certain classifications to make the State more competitive with private sector job classifications in regions where CAD's are authorized.
- Critical Class Adjustment (CCA) A number of classes were identified to receive special pay adjustments. These adjustments apply to Computer, Word Processing, Nursing/Health and Secretarial/Clerical related classes as determined by the Department of Administration.
- 3. Competitive Pay Adjustment (CPA) This adjustment is applied to the minimum of the pay range for all classifications.
- Guaranteed Minimum Adjustment (GMA) This adjustment guarantees the minimum pay increase (\$750.11) approved for all full-time employees, or a prorated amount for part-time employees.

B. Performance Incentive (Merit) Increases

In addition to the annual salary increase, a Performance Incentive Increase of no less than 3% and no more than 5% of an employee's annual base rate of pay (exclusive of any competitive area differential or other salary additives) may be granted to an eligible employee.

The following stipulations apply in determining an employee's eligibility to be considered for a Performance Incentive Increase:

- Only employees with a current annual overall performance appraisal rating of "Exceeds Performance Standards" shall be eligible. The anniversary date for all employees has been re-established based upon the employee's latest appointment to the Career Service System. The schedule of anniversary dates, below, reflects the specific changes to employee anniversary dates.
- Performance Incentive Increases shall not be granted prior to an employee's re-established anniversary date but may be granted on or subsequent to that date. An employee may not be granted more than one Performance Incentive Increase during the fiscal year.
- No Performance Incentive Increase may be granted that will cause the employee's salary to exceed the maximum of the statewide salary range. An increase may be granted at less than 3% in order not to exceed the pay range maximum.
- Eligibility does not guarantee an employee will receive a Performance Incentive Increase.

Each employee's anniversary date has been re-established as follows: (This does not apply to Law Enforcement Officers)

If the employee's latest appointment to the Career Service was effective:

After June 1, 1985

the employee's new anniversary date shall be established as:

July 1, 1985
August 1, 1985
September 1, 1985
October 1, 1985
November 1, 1985
December 1, 1985
January 1, 1986
February 1, 1986
March 1, 1986
April 1, 1986
May 1, 1986
June 1, 1986
Upon completion of 12 months of satisfactory service in the class.

Latest appointment to the Career Service means:

- 1) The date the employee was hired in any Career Service position if there has never been a termination from the Career Service, and/or
- 2) The date the employee was reemployed in a Career Service position if there has been a termination from the Career Service.

C. January 17, 1986, Pay Check

The January 17, 1986, pay check will reflect three days at the old rate and seven days at the new rate. A special stub will be included which reflects the rate of pay as of December 31, 1985, and January 1, 1986. In most cases the difference will equal the "Total Pay Increase" column on the pay increase listing.

Those employees receiving a Performance Incentive Increase in this pay check will have a different "increase" amount reflected on the special stub than on the pay increase listing. For these employees, the "increase" figure on the special stub reflects the "Total Pay Increase" amount and the increase resulting from the Performance Incentive Increase. The Performance Incentive Increase reflected on the pay stub includes a retroactive amount.

For more information about the Performance Incentive Increases, you may refer to the November 20, 1985, memo from Gloria B. Carter to the Deans, Directors and Department Heads.

Career Service employees filling Law Enforcement Classes are not affected by the salary information in this issue of the "Personnel Touch". The instructions applicable to Law Enforcement Classes are in conjunction with the Law Enforcement Step Pay Plan.
