ENRICO A. GIORDANO

Biographical Sketch

Dr. Enrico A. Giordano serves as Associate Dean of University Services and Continuing Education at Florida International University. His appointment to that position was approved by the Board of Regents on June 8, 1970.

Dr. Giordano was Coordinator for Sponsored and International Programs for the State University System of Florida. In that post he coordinated all non-credit activities, including university workshops and conferences, all grants and foundation programs for the system, and oversaw the international programs for the state universities of Florida.

Dr. Giordano is involved in establishing programs in continuing education, extension activities, branch campuses, international conferences, and institutes at Florida International. In addition, he will assist in the preparation of the various off-campus academic programs and in recruiting of staff and faculty.

Dr. Giordano holds his doctorate degree from Michigan State University, a master's degree from the University of Michigan, and a bachelor's degree from Eastern Michigan University.

A native of Windber, Pennsylvania, he was a teacher and principal in the Michigan schools before becoming the Administrator of the St. Petersburg Center of the Florida Institute for Continuing University Studies in 1963.

In 1964 he took over as Assistant Dean and Director of the Resident Conference Programs of the State University System, then taught for a year in the Center for Continuing Education at the University of South Florida before becoming Coordinator for Sponsored and International Programs in 1966.

Giordano, 42, is a member of the National University Extension Association and chairman-elect of the Associate and Assistant Deans Section, Adult Education Association and Phi Delta Kappa.

He is married, with three children.
