Biographical Sketch

David S. Shelton, Assistant Dean of the School of Health and Social Services, has been a member of the faculty since September 1, 1971.

He was formerly Director of Community Health Services and Manpower Planning of the Comprehensive Health Planning Council of South Florida.

Shelton was born in Ann Arbor, Michigan, and received his bachelor of science degree in 1957 from Eastern Michigan University. He received a certificate in physical therapy from Baylor University Medical School in 1959 and his master of arts degree in public health administration in 1965 from the University of North Carolina.

In 1959-60, he was a member of the physical therapy staff of St. Joseph's Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska. During 1960-61, he was Chief of Physical Therapy at the Rehabilitation Center in Huntsville, Alabama. From 1961-64, Mr. Shelton served as Chief of Restorative Services of the Rehabilitation Center in Evansville, Indiana, and in 1964-65, he was an administrator of the Community Health Services in Evansville. During 1966-69, he served as Assistant Director of Community Health Information and Planning Services, Inc., in Syracuse, New York.

Mr. Shelton is a fellow of the American Public Health Association and a member of the faculty of the University of Miami School of Medicine.
