Keith W. Trowbridge serves as Director of Planning and Analysis at Florida International University. His appointment to that position was approved by the Board of Regents on June 8, 1970.

For a period during 1970 and 1971, he was also given the additional duty as Executive Assistant to the President, Charles E. Perry. Trowbridge was Research Analyst and Campus Planner in the Office of Institutional Research at Bowling Green State University for four years and also served as Assistant Director of Institutional Research at the University of Michigan. He received his Ph.D. degree at the Center for the Study of Higher Education at the University of Michigan.

Trowbridge is involved in planning and research activities at the University, including the development of the campus plan, budget and enrollment projections, cost studies, and other institutional research programs.

He holds a master's degree in business administration and a bachelor's degree in economics from Bowling Green, where he was president of the Student Body in 1961. He has been a planning consultant and actively involved in community affairs.

He is a member of the Association of Institutional Research and the American Association of Higher Education.

A native of Ontario, Canada, he and his wife and two sons reside in Coral Gables.
