SUBJECT: STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE DISTRIBUTION FOR 1972 - 73

You recently requested that I propose an allocation of student activity and service fees for Florida International University for 1972-73. As you know, we already have some firm commitments against these funds in terms of specific activities which must be funded by the student fee. These are the Athletic and Recreation Building program (that is \$9.00 per quarter which we must pledge to the retirement of the bonds we are now negotiating), the operation of the health service for the university including any insurance that we might offer, the starting of the operation of the student union and of course, the operating cost of the intercollegiate athletic and intramural program.

The attached proposal from Mr. Arrowsmith indicates that a total of roughly \$320,000 could be expected from the activity and student fee distribution during 1972-73. Mr. Arrowsmith has also made a tentative allocation of these fees and I would appreciate your review and possible discussion at a future meeting of the President's Council. If you have any questions, please advise.

SUBJECT: PROPOSED STUDENT SERVICE AND ACTIVITY FEE DISTRIBUTION 1972-73

I recommend the adoption of the enclosed fee distribution for 1972-73. It should be clearly understood that the amounts per quarter are only close estimates. The actual distribution will be made on the per student allocation times actual full time fee paying students and may result in amounts varying some small amount. Another caution is that the actual money is only available by quarter as the students register; therefore, expenditures should be planned so that amounts per quarter are not exceeded. In those activities where the majority of expenses will come during the first quarter (as ID Cards) an allocation from the contingency reserve may be necessary in the first quarter to be repaid in later quarters.
