ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-SEVEN YEARS AGO THOMAS JEFFERSON STOOD BEFORE A SMALL CROWD IN CHARLOTTESVILLE, VIRGINIA, TO ANNOUNCE THE OFFICIAL OPENING OF THE NATION'S FIRST STATE UNIVERSITY -- THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA. HE TOLD THOSE ASSEMBLED HOW PLEASED HE WAS THAT AFTER SIX YEARS OF PLANNING AND PREPARATION THE NEW INSTITUTION WOULD OPEN FOR A BEGINNING CLASS OF FORTY STUDENTS.

Today, I stand before you to announce that this nation's newest state university -- Florida International University -officially opens on this day after thirty-six months of planning and preparation for a beginning class numbering almost 6,000 -- three times more students than any other new university has opened with in the history of the United States. THOMAS JEFFERSON WAS JUSTLY PROUD TO BE THE FOUNDING PRESIDENT OF THE NATION'S FIRST STATE UNIVERSITY. AND I AM EQUALLY PROUD TO HAVE BEEN SELECTED TO BE THE FIRST PRESIDENT OF THE NATION'S NEWEST STATE UNIVERSITY.

As a grateful first president, I stand before you with a full heart:

. . . FULL BECAUSE YOU ARE HERE TO CELEBRATE THIS HISTORIC DAY IN THE YOUNG LIFE OF THIS UNIVERSITY --A DAY THAT REPRESENTS A DREAM THAT HAS BECOME A REALITY FOR THIS GREAT REGION OF OUR STATE, AND THIS DAY PROVIDES A DEEP SENSE OF SATISFACTION TO SO MANY, ESPECIALLY THOSE MEMBERS OF THE 1965 DADE DELEGATION WHO SPONSORED THE SUCCESSFUL LEGISLATION THAT ESTABLISHED FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY. THIS INSTITUTION SHALL ALWAYS REMEMBER SENATORS HOLLAHAN AND HAVERFIELD AND REPRESENTATIVES BAKER, DUBBIN, GONG, MACKENZIE, MYERS, PETTIGREW, POSTON, SHEVIN, SPENCER AND WEISSENBORN FOR THEIR PARTICIPATION IN MAKING THIS DAY POSSIBLE.

. . . FULL BECAUSE OF THE ASSISTANCE THAT FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL HAS RECEIVED FROM ALL ELEMENTS OF THIS COMMUNITY -- FROM BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY, FROM THE PROFESSIONS, FROM THE PRIVATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, FROM THE PUBLIC COMMUNITY COLLEGES, FROM THE POLITICAL AND GOVERNMENTAL LEADERS, FROM THE YOUNG AND THE OLD, FROM THE BLACK AND THE WHITE, FROM THE SPANISH SPEAKING CITIZENS AND THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY --FROM EVERYONE!

. . . FULL BECAUSE OF THE HIGH CALIBER OF FACULTY AND STAFF THAT WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO BRING TO THE UNIVERSITY FROM ALL AREAS OF THIS NATION AND FROM VARIOUS PARTS OF THE GLOBE TO WORK WITH THE OUTSTANDING GROUP OF STUDENTS WHO WILL BE IN OUR FIRST CLASS. . . . Full because of the hard work, creative thinking and total dedication that this University and its president have received from the faculty and staff during the last 1,165 days. Their enthusiastic cooperation has enabled this institution to develop new and exciting programs that will make Florida International a living and vital force in society.

• FULL BECAUSE OF THE CONTINUOUS ENCOURAGEMENT AND ASSISTANCE THAT THIS UNIVERSITY HAS RECEIVED FROM THE BOARD OF REGENTS, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE. THEY HAVE REALLY MADE THIS DAY POSSIBLE AND WE SHALL ALWAYS BE APPRECIATIVE FOR THEIR SUPPORT. . . . AND, FINALLY, MY HEART IS ESPECIALLY FULL BECAUSE OF THE LOVE THAT MY FAMILY HAS SHOWN FOR ME DURING THE PAST THREE YEARS. THEY HAVE PUT UP WITH AN ALMOST IMPOSSIBLE SITUATION -- CONTINUOUS LONG HOURS, OCCASSIONAL SHORT TEMPERS AND AN ABUNDANCE OF PROMISES TO SPEND MORE TIME WITH THEM, NONE OF WHICH CAME TRUE. FOR ACCEPTING THIS BURDEN WITH A DEEP AND SINCERE UNDERSTANDING, I SHALL ALWAYS BE GRATEFUL TO YOU BETTY, TO YOU TOM, AND TO YOU LYNN.

THIS DAY WILL BE RECORDED IN THE HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY AS THE BEGINNING. LET US REMEMBER, THEREFORE, THAT FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY WAS BORN TODAY TO SERVE ALL OF THE TOMORROWS THAT FOLLOW. AND LET US ALWAYS BE MINDFUL OF OUR CONTINUED COMMITMENT AND DEDICATION TO KNOWLEDGE, SERVICE AND UNDERSTANDING AS EXPRESSED IN THE GOALS OF THE UNIVERSITY. Now, I am honored to declare that at <u>10:57</u> A.M. ON September 14, 1972, Florida International University is officially open and we are very pleased to take our place as a member of The State University System of Florida
