BECERRA FERNANDEZ SAID THIS PROGRAM COULD BECOME KEY IN THE CAREERS OF MINORITY STUDENTS WHO MAY NOT HAVE ENGINEER ROLE MODELS IN THEIR FAMILY OR CIRCLE OF FRIENDS. APPROXIMATELY 16 STUDENT-MENTOR TEAMS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND THE BREAKFAST WHERE THE PROGRAM WILL BE LAUNCHED.
